CONDITIONS

Marking of plots reserved for future use is the responsibility of the person, or family, reserving them. Soon after reserving a plot, and prior to erecting a permanent head stone, a temporary marker should be placed flush with the ground so not to interfere with mowing of the grass. This is to help ensure that reserved plots are not mistakenly used by others. Temporary markers can be made from 3" PVC pipe caps or by forming concrete in a tin can. Initials should be inscribed on the top. They can also be purchased from a monument company. Should assistance be needed in marking reserved plots contact Richard Hale at 479-848-3179.

Before the gravesite is opened, it is requested that one of the Cemetery Association Board Members be contacted to verify the location. This will help avoid any possible misunderstanding.

Use of the above identified burial plot(s) is restricted to maintenance of the grave site. No improvements to the plot area other than a head stone or foot stone shall be constructed without the express consent of the Dutch Mills Cemetery Association Board.
