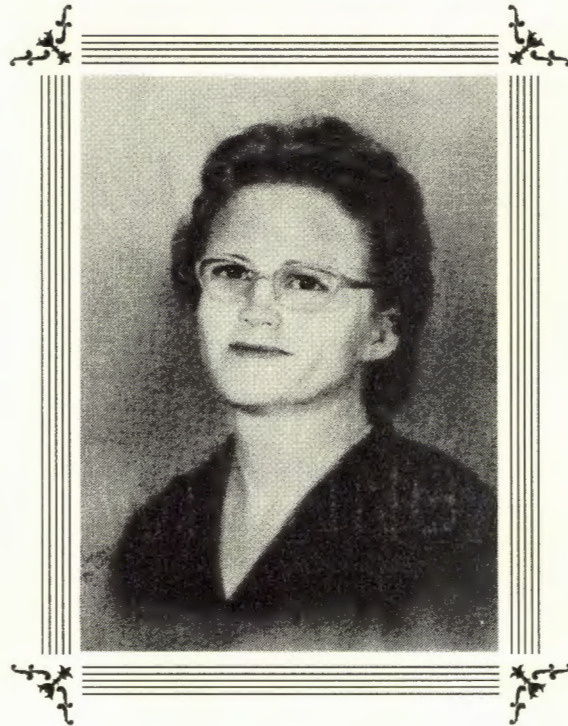

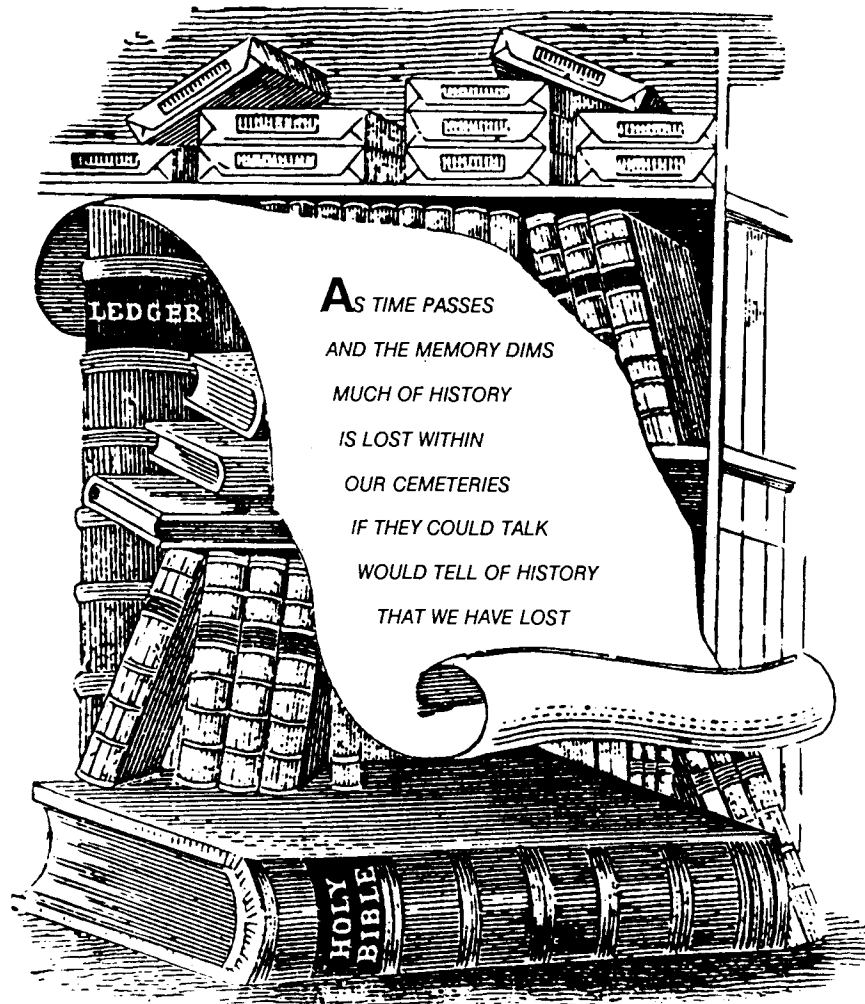

All of his friends like to call him "Jim"*

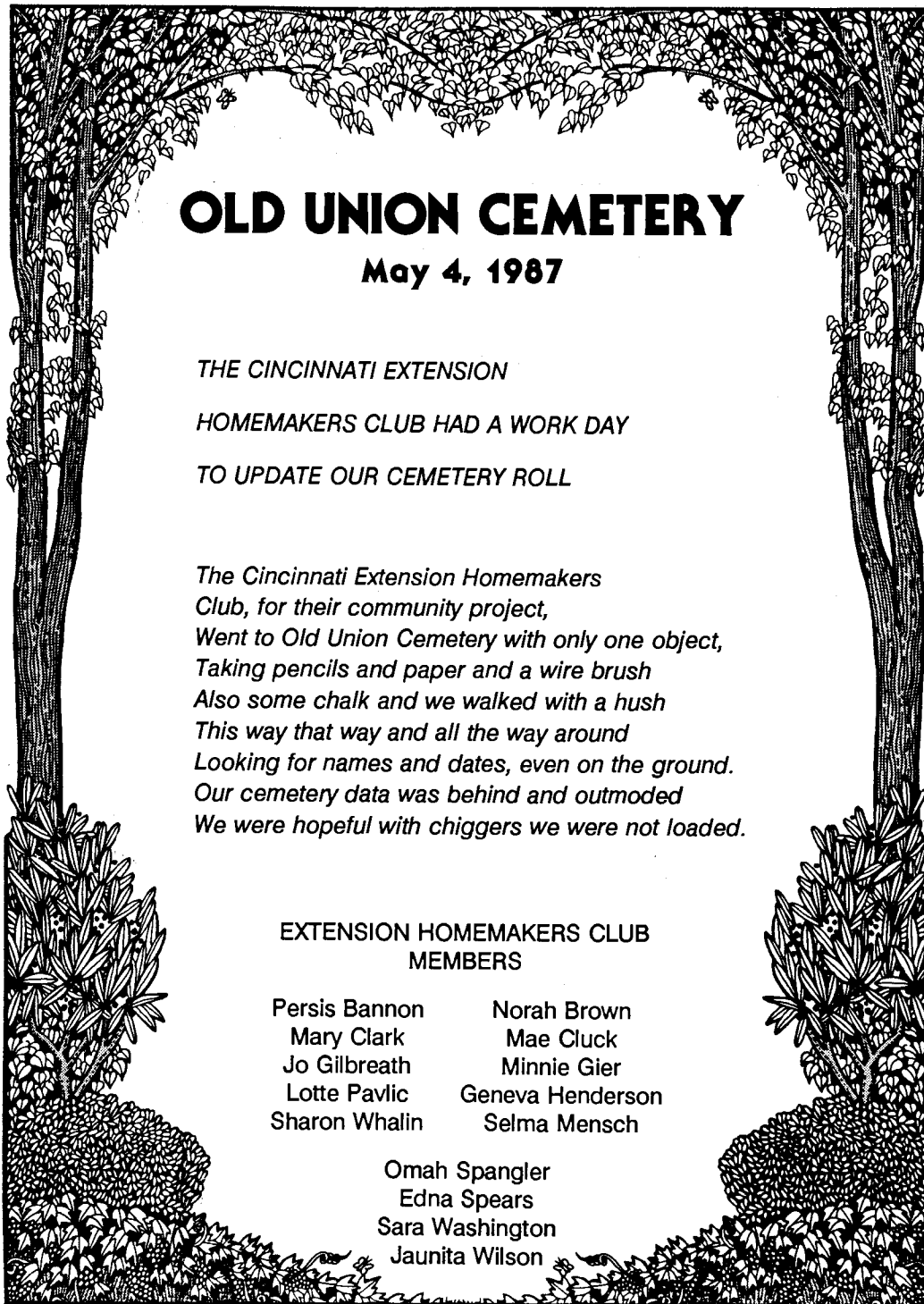

Old Union
Cincinnati's Cemetery Since
July 1846 - Its Early History

The following report was written
by Mr. John H. Parks one of the
oldest and most respected citizens
of Illinois Township, read by him
at an assembly gathered at the
old Cincinnati grave yard, for the
purpose of making arrangements
to clean the grounds and keep
them in permanent repair.

Nathan D. Hanks

Nathan D. Hanks, better known as "Brother Hanks," was an early day minister. He was much like the early day circuit rider only he made his circuit by walking. He lived at Lincoln, Arkansas, and walked to Cincinnati and surrounding areas to preach. He was a Presbyterian minister and would often stay overnight in the home of the people in his circuit. He ministered at weddings, burying the dead, and comforting those that needed him. He always carried his Bible and his violin. Many enjoyed his musical ability as well as his preaching.

JOHN HAMILTON PARKS

John H. Parks, often called, "Uncle John Parks," was born in Hopinsville, Kentucky, June 26, 1836. His father, Walter Davis Parks, born 1803, Virginia, brought his family to the Cincinnati area in 1849. He died shortly thereafter and was buried in "Old Union Cemetery," 1850.

John H. Parks was the fourth child in a family of eleven children. He was 14 years of age and took on much responsibility when his father died. He was educated at "The Cane Hill College." He was census enumerator in Washington Co. Ark., 1860. He was a soldier in the Civil War, serving in Co. B, 34th Inf., Ark. He was a Democrat. He was converted and joined the "Cumberland Presbyterian Church," at a young age. Later he was ordained "ruling elder" and held that office through his entire life.

He married Kate Gibson, September 20, 1860. To them was born four children, William Almer Parks, John James Parks, Walter Davis Parks, and Lizzie Dean Parks. All of these children were born and reared in this community. Most of this family is buried in "Old Union Cemetery."

John H. Parks died January 26, 1917, a caring man noted for his many kind deeds, among them, his caring for "Old Union Cemetery."

Report Given by John H. Parks, early 1900

Early History of "Old Union"
Cincinnati's Cemetery
Since July 1846

I was appointed to prepare &
give a history of Old Union
Graveyard.

The deed to the lot does not
say anything about the
graveyard so I will tell of
"Union Meeting House"

The land was deeded to
W^m Barclay, Geo Gibson, Thos West
Elijah Carter, & John Odle

Trustees of Union Meeting House
Lot, containing one acre.

The Citizens went to Illinois River and
cut & hewed Pine logs to build the
house. It was seated with Stakes
with holes bored to put legs in.

My Father moved to the Reagan place July 1849 Three yrs after the deed was made to the Church Lot. I have lived here ever since. There are only two persons now living who were grown when I came here. They are Mrs. Nathan West and Mr. Clem C. Clayton.

About 1852 the house was ceiled overhead by subscription.

About 1854 The Sons of Temperance seated the house with good seats, and soon after was weatherboarded by subscription.

The Good Templars ceiled inside walls in 1857

Soon after the War, some of the Citizens met in Cincinnati to elect trustees; as none of the old ones were living but one & he was not here. Those elected were

Wm. Paston Barclay, Daniel
B. Mason & John H. Parks Trustees
of Union Meeting House.

In 1872 the Citizens bought 2 A.
of land from Thos. P. Marquess:

It was deeded to Trustees above.
In 1886 Citizens wanted to fence
Union & Grave yd lots.

As the branch cut the Church lot
Marquess agreed to take all on
north side of branch & give us
land on east side of Graveyard.

The Trustees agreed to exchange.
The Church-house was put up
for sale to bidder, Mr. Har Moore
got the house and the money
went to fence the lot.

I am only Trustee living. I hope
you will make new ones.

I have the deeds & will give them
to new Trustees. - John H. Parks

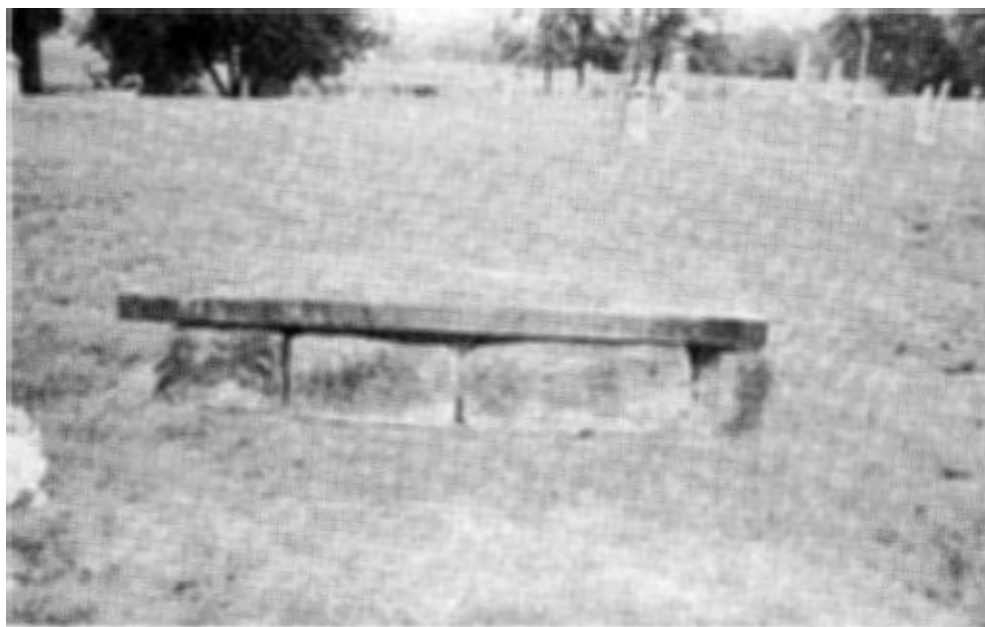
OLDEST KNOWN GRAVE

Col. Daniel Thomason, b. 1801, Tenn., d. 7-28-1839, bur. Old Union Cemetery. In 1821 Col. Daniel Thomason married Mary Jane Denton. They were living in Warren County, Tenn., when the pioneer spirit urged them to move on. Accompanied by his father and other family members, Daniel organized an oxen drawn wagon train. Loading their furniture and supplies, the families started west. They had heard rumors of lush open country there. Their route brought them over rough and hilly terrain, through most of Tennessee and all of the way across Arkansas into Washington County. They stopped first at Rheas Mill. Later hearing about the valley further west, Daniel brought his family into the wild and sparsely settled valley, now known as Cincinnati, Ark. Here the family acquired extensive acreage. Tilling the soil and building a home the family settled in. Daniel's adventure was destined to be short lived. He died July 28, 1839, a young man of 38 years. Some say it was a fever that took his life.

Mary Jane Denton Thomason, continuing with her strong pioneer spirit, lived on the land and reared her children. This same spirit called generations of Thomason's to till this same soil for 150 years.

Computation makes us think Daniel Thomason was buried elsewhere and later moved to Old Union Cemetery.

Cemetery Pioneers



POSTON

WILLIAM POSTON, b. 1779, d. 5-12-1848, bur. Old Union Cemetery, Cincinnati, Ark. Age 69 years. Wm. Poston's grave is covered by a solid 4'x6' rock which stands about 12" above the ground. It is a remarkable monument. W. C. (William Carroll) Poston, b. 1817, d. 10-22-1858, bur. Old Union Cemetery, Cincinnati, Ark. Age 41 years. The Poston's were one of the very earliest pioneers to come into this area. Their acquired lands were extensive. It is reputed that they had cotton plantations and owned slaves to work the crops.

W. C. (WILLIAM CARROLL) POSTON was probably the son of William Poston. Their land laid from near Cincinnati, on west to Indian Territory and then running north. When W. C. (William Carroll) died in 1858, there was a dispute over the land. His wife's name was Bathseba (Tilley). His children were William T. Poston, John J. Poston (under 21) and a daughter Jane Poston McAdams, married to Thomas McAdams. In this dispute, the negro slaves were divided among his heirs.

OLD UNION CEMETERY, CINCINNATI, ARKANSAS

JULY 1846 - JULY 1988

Old Union Cemetery is located one mile south of the village, Cincinnati, Arkansas. This cemetery is very unique. There are graves known to be in this cemetery with no markings at all, others have only a sandstone marker with no names or dates. Many of these are in the southeast corner and mark the graves of slaves, belonging to the various slaver owners in the area. We have found 150 unidentified sandstone markers and 685 identified burials.

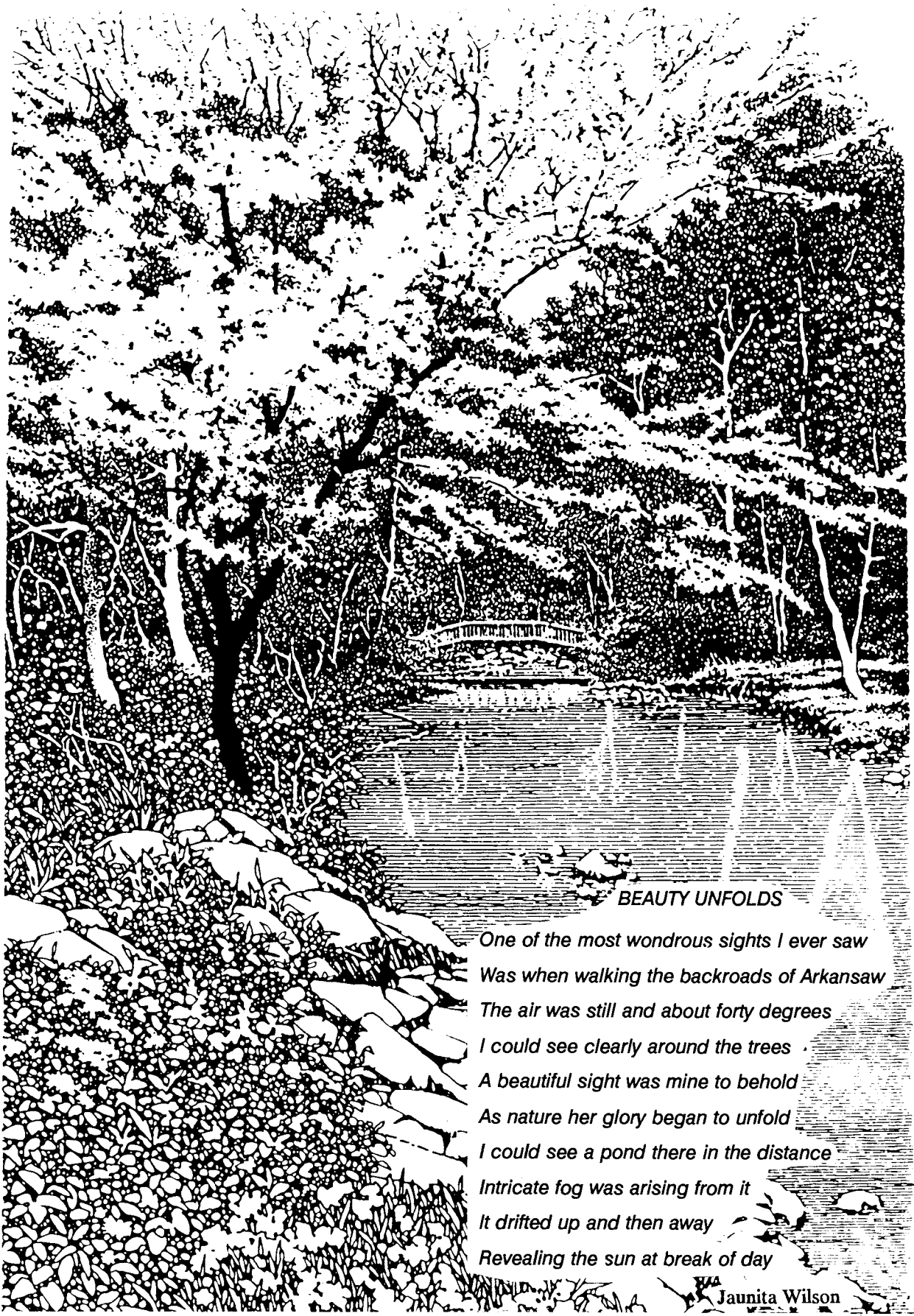

BEATY CEMETERY AT CINCINNATI, ARKANSAS

RECORDED MARCH 7, 1969 BY CINCINNATI E.H.C.

This small, family cemetery is located on land once owned by the early Beaty's in this area. The land is now owned by H.L. Gilbreath. The Beaty's settled there when they came into this sparsely settled area, probably around 1829. Thomas Beaty was in the Washington County Census of that year. As most of the early settlers did, he made his living from the land. He was from Clinton County Kentucky, and married Nancy Odle. They reared 7 children, 5 boys and 2 girls. Thomas died at the young age of 45 years. These families were prominent in early Cincinnati history.

Located west, just off Ark. 59 highway, on the Washington County and Benton County line road near the Bryant's home, this cemetery is all but lost. There are many sandstone markers and three graves with large rocks bordering them. I found 23 identifiable graves scattered about. There was a small, fenced center plot with the following burials:

Read August 4, 1988. Approximately 400 identifiable burials were found, 42 of them being Kirk family. Also, 40 unidentified fieldstone markers, painted white.

Located from Summers, Ark., on highway 62. Go west 1/2 mile, turn south and go 3/4 mile to end of road. This cemetery, on the west bank of Ballard Creek, is beautiful and well kept. It impresses one as being a virtual fortress carved from the wilderness. It has a chain link fence surrounding the two acre plot, keeping the forest out. Two huge oak trees guard the entrance to the cemetery. The land was donated by D.C. Price. His wife, Catherine, died 6-27-1870 and was the first burial in Ganderville Cemetery.

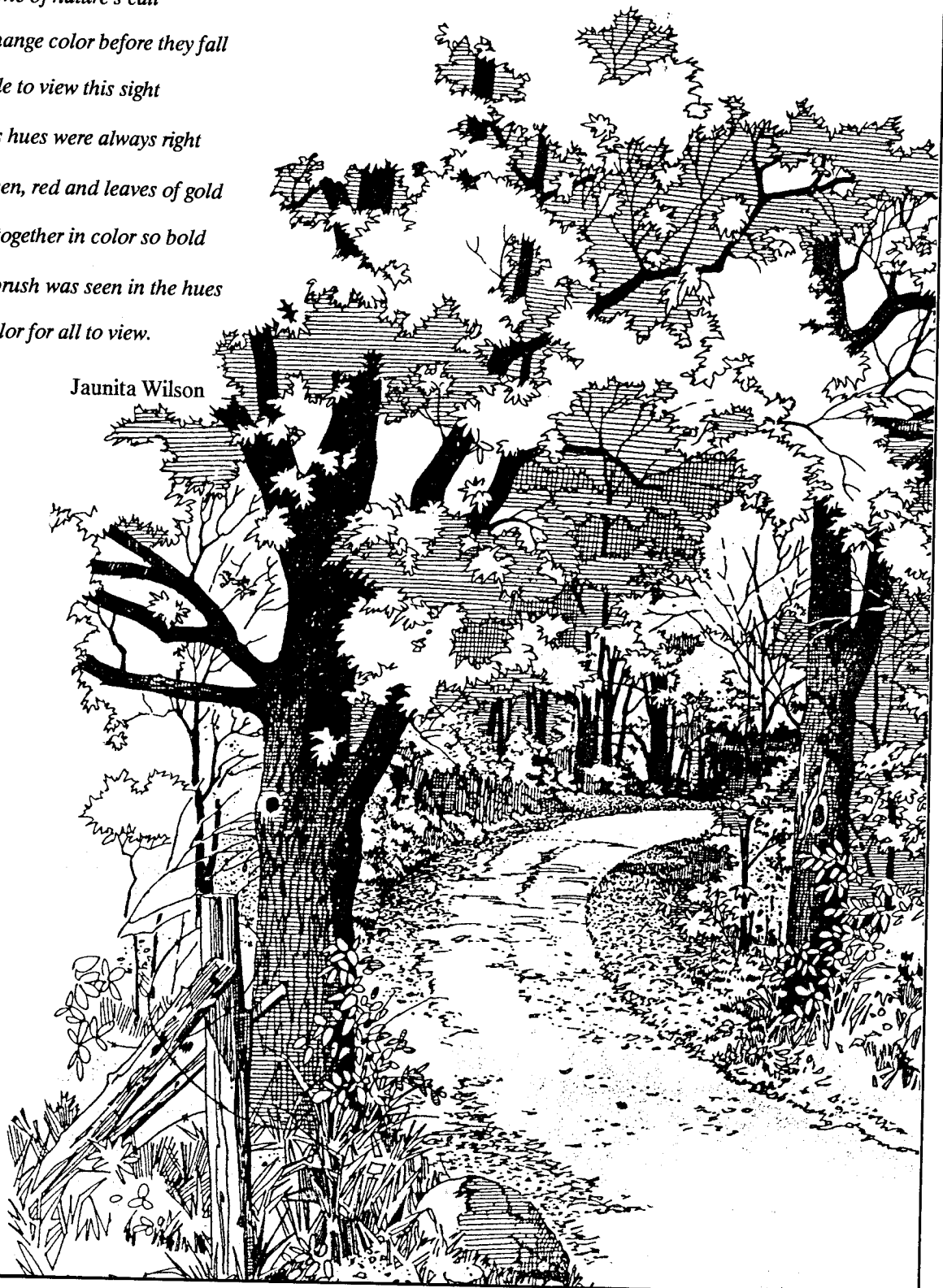

Weddington Cemetery

WEDDINGTON CEMETERY

This well kept cemetery, approximately 7-1/2 acres, is located south of Hwy. 16, near the Weddington community. Both were named for one of the early families who settled there.

William (Bill) Weddington came into the area near 1828. His young daughter, Mary, born 1828, died 1842 is the first known burial in the cemetery. The Baptist church beside the cemetery was first organized in 1871. Many changes have been made since then.

The arch above the cemetery gateway reads, 1842-1942, commemorating 100 years at that time. Hundreds of sandstone markers are in this cemetery with no way of identifying who was buried there. There are approximately 1,000 identifiable burials at this time.

West/Pool Cemetery

WEST - POOL CEMETERY**BURIALS RECORDED BY CINCINNATI E.H.C. 1969**

This cemetery lies approximately one and one-half miles due west of the Old Union Cemetery on land that was once owned by James S. West, a very remarkable businessman in this area. He was the son of James and Ann West from Tenn. In 1832, at the young age of 18, he arrived in Washington County Arkansas and settled at Viney Grove. He married his first wife, Miss Mary Crawford, and had nine children. His son, Alva G. West, was born 11-25-1837 at Viney Grove. A daughter, Ann, married Capt. Alvin Beaty, and daughter, Harriet, married C.H. Mason. He married his second wife, Mrs. Pittman, and had three children. His third wife, Miss R. Jane Crawford, was a distant relative of his first wife, and together they had four children. Two of these children died in infancy and are buried in Old Union Cemetery, 1869.

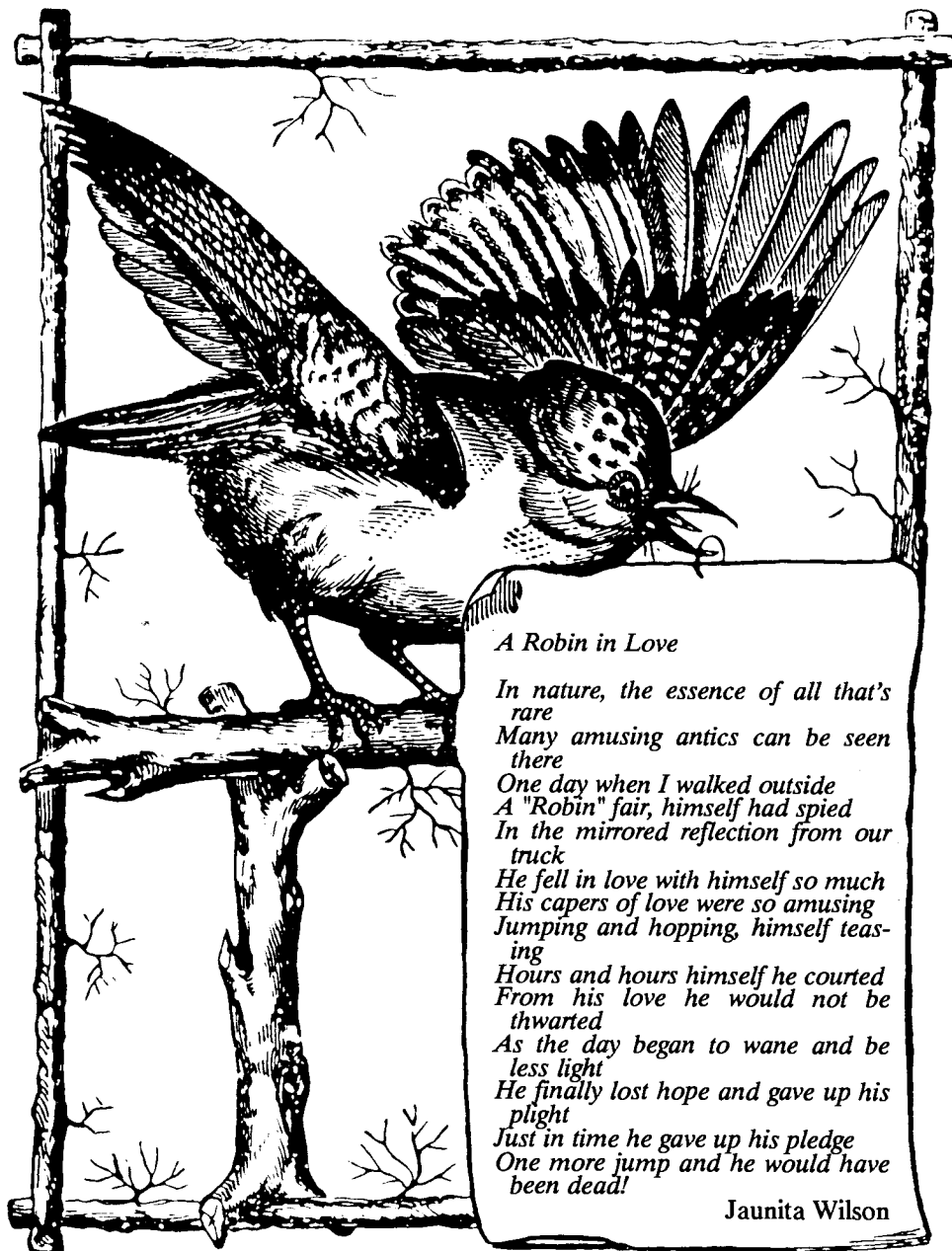

A Robin in Love

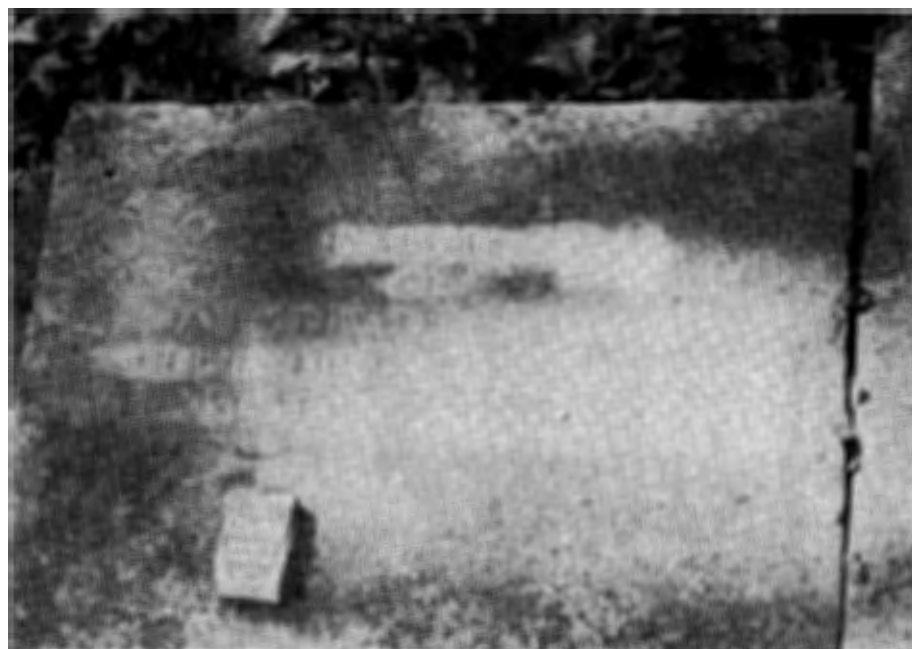
*In nature, the essence of all that's rare

LITTLE LOST CEMETERY

Located about 1 mile east of Gibson Parks Cemetery at least 12 sandstone markers, no identification. One grave easily read and two only partially.

*Little cemetery lost in trees and vines
you have secrets all entwined
1838 was so long ago
Please, of your secrets let us know*

With loving care they engraved her name on the stone and laid to rest their little ones. Alice E. Reagan, d. 9-20-1838, age 16 mo. (Probably related to the Reagan mentioned in Mr. Parks' letter, page 7.)

The two are laid to rest side-by-side. A 4 inch sandstone slab 30x55 covers each grave. The engraving has faded away.

I have been told Daniel Thomason b. 8-25-1801, d. 7-28-1839 was buried first in this "Little Lost Cemetery" and later moved to "Old Union."

I have visited Little Lost Cemetery three times trying to decipher the surname on the twin graves, to no avail.



There is an excerpt to the story of "Little Lost Cemetery." Not satisfied with our former findings my daughter, Glenita Guthrie, and I went once again to visit the cemetery. We crawled through the fence at Jim Frye's place and walked through the woods until we reached the cemetery. We had already viewed pictures taken at the site of the twin graves. The crew at the Siloam Springs Printing office had all agreed the surname on the twin graves could be

PRATT. We took with us chalk and crayons and rubbed them across the engraving on the stones. It was so hard to read, but we still felt the name must be PRATT.

Having read James Eugene Gibson's recount of the Gibson family in the "Cincinnati History Book," I even wondered if the burials could be some of the John McPhail family who had lived on the Jimmie Cluck farm along about 1830. We did research on the John McPhail's and found he was in Benton County by 1830 or thereabouts, we dismissed the McPhail name. At first we thought the years of death for the two graves were 1816 and 1818, but realized that this was most likely not feasible. Glenita, whose eyesight is much better than mine, discovered faint markings making 16 and 18 into 46 and 48, thereby the death dates being 1846 and 1848.

We decided to do more research at the court house and found where a Zenas and Margaret PRATT had sold land in the vicinity of "Little Lost Cemetery" back in 1848. We felt we now had proof of the identify of the little babies buried there.



The sale of the land, two forty-acre plots, was to one Joel P. Blair. Blair is listed in Goodspeed as being postmaster of Sylva post office in 1849. We checked with James Eugene Gibson on the description of the property. He thought the land was probably close by the little cemetery. We checked with J.O. Beaty about the Robert R. Beaty who was a witness to the sale of the land. He knew many Beaty's had lived in this vicinity and thought Robert could have been one of their children. We are satisfied we have found the answer to our mystery.

Now another mystery! Donnie Jackson has wited this site and says there are 17 burials on it. Most of us have heard of water witching with a part of a tree limb. Grave witching seems far out, a sort of wizardry to it. I was an unbeliever of this until one day Buck and I were at the Wedington Cemetery when John D. Moss was witching there. We watched apprehensively as the wire in his hand turned each time he approached the right spot where there was a grave. Seeing our dubious glances he offered us his witching wire and told us to hold it lightly or in a loose manner. We did this and found the witching wire did indeed turn of its own will. Don't ask me why, I do not know why. I only know it moved of its own free will. Now I believe! I believe Donnie Jackson when he says there are 17 burials in "Little Lost Cemetery."

Our grandchildren: Maegan Randolph, Jonathan Randolph, and Aimee Guthrie were participants in this search for identity for the two little babes, there in the woods.

This indenture made this twenty eight day of November AD one thousand eight hundred and forty eight by and between Zenas Pratt and his wife Margratt Pratt of the County of Washington State of Arkansas of the first part and Joel P. Blair of the County and State aforesaid of the second part. Whereas the said party of the first part for and in the consideration of the sum of Two hundred Dollars to them paid the receipt thereof do hereby acknowledge, have sold and by these presents do convey unto the said Joel P. Blair the following described parcel or tract of Land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid known and designated on the plot of the United States survey as being South West quarter of the North West quarter of section No thirty four in Township No sixteen North of Range thirty three West containing forty acres, also the North East quarter of the South West quarter of section No thirty four in Township No sixteen North in Range no thirty three West containing forty acres, with all and singular the improvement thereon, to the said Joel P. Blair and to his heirs to have and to hold forever and we the said Zenas Pratt and his wife Margratt Pratt doth bind ourselves ourselves, heirs and assigns, to warrant and forever defend the right of the above described premises to be good to the said Joel P. Blair. In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and applied our seals this day and year first above written
