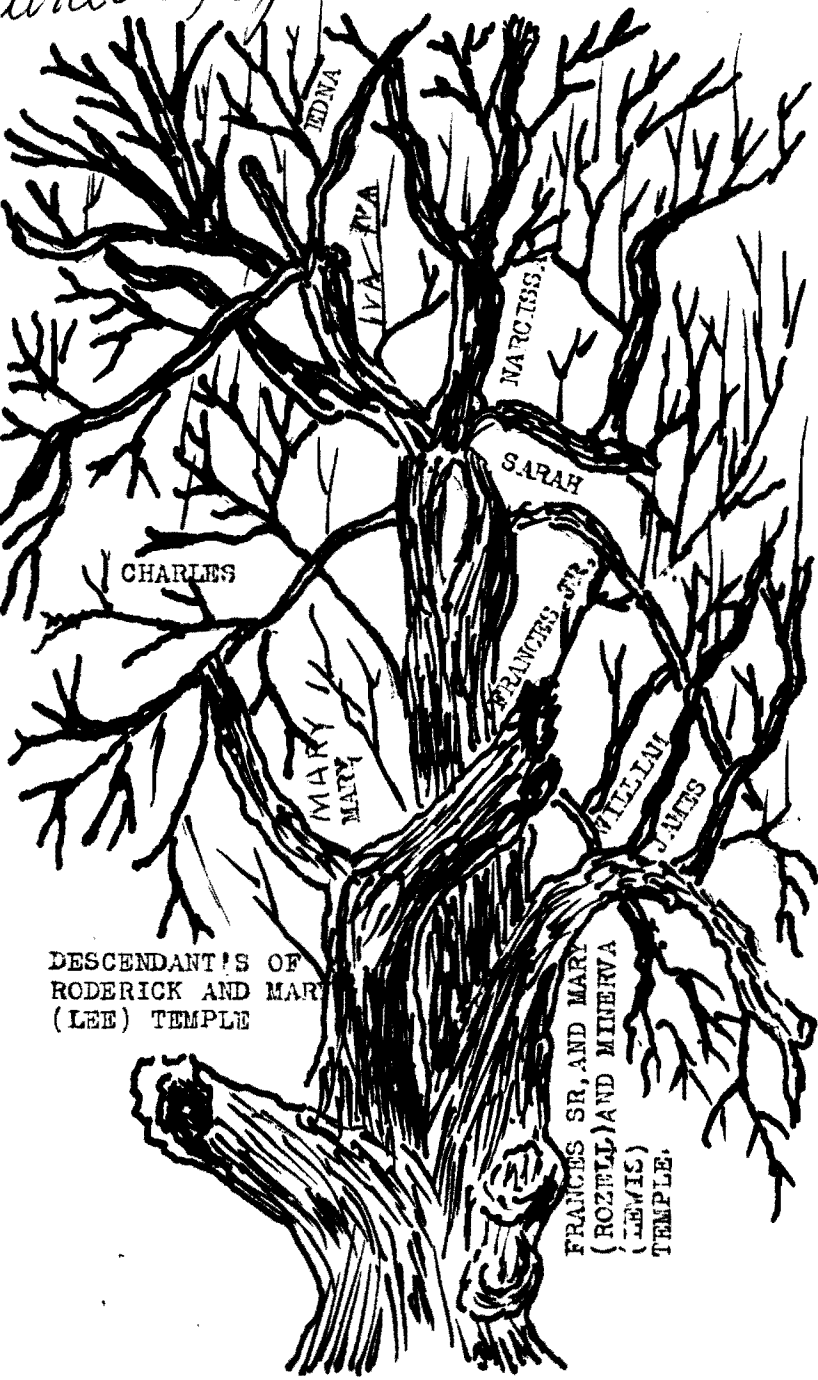

First I want to thank each and every one that has helped me obtain the information contained in this book. I really appreciate your cooperation.

I was born June 22nd, 1892 in a small log cabin located three and one half miles northwest of Rudy, Arkansas in Crawford County. I have learned it was considered a old cabin at the time of my birth. It was destroyed by fire a few years ago about 1968. I grew up in Crawford County. The only schooling I got was in a one room school known as the Mountain View School located on the corner of my grandfather's (Frances Marion Temple) homestead. The information I have puts me at about nine years of age when I started to school and never completing grade school. We had six months of school a year, three in the summer and the other three in the winter and I did not have the privilege to attend regular. It is not necessary to mention this for everyone that reads this book will know that I had very little education. I expect some criticism, but I hope each one that reads the book will be able to put it together and learn something.

When I started this genealogy about 1965 I planned to obtain all the information I could to have something to work from and then make a tour of the United States and contact all the relatives I could and make a search of records concerning our

ancesters. I planned on being six months or a year doing this but on account of my health I had to give up this idea and do what I could by mail. I have tried to bring my grandfathers's (Temple and Madden) decendants up to date. I may lack a few of the younger ones.

I obtained a copy of the family history of Abraham Temple, the first Temple to come to the United States of America, (mentioned in the back of this book) in hopes I could connect my great grandfather (Roderick Temple) with some of these decendants, but there has been a limb broken off the tree sometime and destroyed.

I plan to continue my search on our ancestors and if I learn anything you will hear from me. But remember I am living on borrowed time.

The wife and I have just celebrated our 60th anniversary on February 8th, 1973. We have had eight children, twenty two grandchildren, thirty nine great grandchildren and all are living. By the time you read this there will be another great grandchild and another grandson married. I might also add that all our in-laws, our grandchildren's husbands and wives are still living.

Roderick Temple

The first record we found of Roderick Temple was from a Family Bible, recording his birth Oct, 13, 1787. nothing known about his parents or his birth place some think he was born in Georgie. some Kentucky, and others in Virginia. have not been able to find any record in either of the states. The second record found was where he joined the Tennessee Militia under the command of Colonel Cheathaw. He was honorably discharged Apr, 10, 1813. at Fayetteville, Lincoln Co. Tenn. He was six feet and upwards, fair complexion, blue eyes, and dark hair. The third record was where he obtained his marriage license Sept, 27, 1817 in Williams Co. Frankfort, Tenn. married Oct. 2, 1817 to Mary Lee, by a Clergman named Adkinson. Mary born in Virginia 1799. and came to Tennessee with her parents when a small girl. Her father was a second cousin to General Robert E. Lee. Mary lost contact of her parents. Have not learned if they died in Tenn. or went back to Virginia. The Lee family was formerly wealthy, and there are lots of books on the Lee family in state libraries. Anyone with plenty of money and time could trace this record. Roderick Temple was a farmer and moved from Williams Co to Davidson Co. Tenn. about 1843 and lived there until his death in 1849. He and family had planed to move to Ark. before he got sick. After his death Mary and the younger part of the family moved to Crawford Co. Ark. and settled in the flat-trock community, later moved near Rudy Ark. where she lived the rest of her life. She died July 30, 1884 at the age of 85 years. She may have lived with one of her grand-son's (William A. Temple) she helped to

raise, at the the time of her death, She came to Ark. about 1850, All her twelve children was born in Williams Co. Tenn.

Narcissa Temple, born Aug.20,1818. married a Mr. Horn, in her later days she came to Ark. and lived with her brother (Frances Marion) until her death.

Mariah Temple, born Sept. 21,1820. nothing (known about her.

Fredrick L.Temple, born Sept.23.1822. last (heard of in Tennessee.

Alexander B.Temple, born March 30.1825,twin, (last heard of in Tennessee.

Silas B.Temple, Twin brother to Alexander (last heard of in tennessee.

Jamse Mitchel Temple, born Oct.28.1827. (last heard of in tennessee.

Frances Marion Temple, born June 2.1830. Came to Ark. with his mother and family.

Roderick H.Temple, Jr. born March 10.1833, Mary B.Temple, born Feb.15.1835. married a

one child died in infancy. nothing known about Roderick Jr.. Mary B. and Eliza Ann.

Francis Marion Temple born June 2. 1830, Williams Co. Tenn. son of Roderick and Mary (Lee) Temple. Francis was raised on the farm in Tenn. and very little schooling.

Francis had a natural gift mechanics, but engaged in farming principally, after his

father's death he helped to care for the family. He came with his mother and family to Crawford Co. Ark. about 1850 and settled in the flatrock community east of Van Buren. about three years later they moved to Oliver Springs community near Rudy. Sept. 28. 1854 Frances married Mary Rozell, Mary born about 1835 daughter of Milton Burns and Sarah (Cottrel) Rozell. Milton born in 1802 in North Carolina, Sarah born 1812, Hazel Green, Alabama. Two sons born to Frances and Mary. James Milton and William Alexander. Mary died about June 5. 1859, buried in the Winfry Cemetery north of Rudy. Ark.

Frances enlisted in the Union Army 1862 joining Company D. the first Ark. Volunteer Cavalry. He was present in the battles of Fayetteville, Elkhorn, and Prairie Grove. where he was wounded He was honorably discharged at Fayetteville, Ark. 1865. March 29. 1863 he married Minerva Lewis born Mar. 1. 1841 in Texas Co. Missouri. daughter of Henry and Jane A. (Hobough) Lewis. Frances and Minerva married at Fayetteville. Ark. by Rev. Reuben North. Chaplin of the first Ark. Cavalry.

Henry Lewis and Jane Hobough were married in Missouri and came to Ark. when there daughter Minerva was about 12 years old. they lived there for the remainder of there lives. Henry born in Missouri died about 1860. Jane A. born in Holland, died Aug. 19. 1895. They had a son Henry Jr. never married, another daughter Sindy married Hade Carney, Two sons born to them, Grover and Thurman. Grover married Ola Carney, daughter of Mr. Mrs. Jess Johnson. Thurman married Tony Kenner daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Roy Sr. Kenner

Francis homesteaded 160 acres about four miles northwest of Rudy. Ark. and there he and Minerva spent the rest of their lives. Francis was a republican, a member of G.A.R. He donated one acre of land to build a schoolhouse known as the Mountain View School. Francis died March 1. 1905 on Minerva's birthday, Minerva died Dec. 14. 1928. both were members of the Methodist Church and buried in the Marrison Cemetery north of Rudy. Ark. seven children born to this union: Mary Tennessee. Francis Marion Jr. Charles Herbert. Sarah Eliza. Narcissa Irene. Iva Thomas. and Edna.

James Milton Temple born Oct. 14. 1855. near Rudy. Ark. Crawford Co. son of Frances Marion Sr. and Mary (Rozell) Temple. married Mary Elizabeth Madden Oct. 27. 1881. daughter of James and Margaret Madden. Mary E. born Dec. 9. 1861 in Tenn. James Milton raised on the farm and farmed all his life in Crawford Co. Ark. except about eight years he farmed near Sallisaw. Okla., They bought a farm three and one half miles northwest of Rudy. Ark. where they lived until retiring, then moved to Van Buren. Ark., living there until death. James M. died Oct. 30. 1933, Mary E. died May 4. 1935. buried in Morrison Cemetery north of Rudy. Ark. they were members of the Methodist Church, and the parents of five children: Bertie Elnora; Bessie Roseta; Freddie born Feb. 26. died the next day Feb. 27. 1890. Elmer Edwin; Frankie born March 23. 1896 and died Dec. 4. 1898 at Sequayah Co. Okla.

Bertie Elnora Temple, born September 24. 1882. in Crawford Co. Ark. near Rudy daughter of James M. and Mary E Temple. married

Marion Addison Stephens February 14, 1900, in Crawford County, Arkansas. M. Addison born 1877 Scott County, Arkansas son of Henry Hudson and Armandy Stephens. Marion Addison a farmer after marriage lived in Sequayah County, near Sallisaw, Oklahoma the rest of their life. Addison was saved in the Baptist Church and died in 1939. Bertie a member of the Methodist Church died in 1952. Both were buried near Sallisaw. Five children born to this union, all in Sequayah County. Edna, Vera born 1903 and died 1909, Bessie, Golda Milton, and Obed James.

Edna Stephens born December 7, 1901, daughter of Marion Addison and Bertie Elnora Stephens, married Walter Lee November 24, 1922 in Sequayah County, Oklahoma. They are the parents of one daughter. Fay Elizabeth born August 9, 1923, married November 27, 1940 to George O. Sanders. They live at 324-East Redwood, Sallisaw, Oklahoma 74955. They have two boys, Kevin who is 22 years old and 12 year old Rodney. George O. works at the Post Office while his wife works at the Court House.

Edna married her second husband, Frank Graham, on February 21, 1926. Frank was born September 9, 1871, in Arkansas son of John and Molly Graham. He was a farmer and merchant in Sallisaw. He died in 1947 but Edna his widow still operates the store at 318-West Cherakee. Two sons born to this union are Frank Edward and Paul.

Frank Edward born February 12, 1927, married November 13, 1948 to Mary Lou Palmer. Frank Edward is a farmer and stockman. They live on rural route, Sallisaw, Oklahoma and are parents of three sons, Dwight, David, and Dean.

 W. Paul Graham born February 15, 1928, at Sallisaw married Geraldine Belinda Brewer December 23, 1946. The three children born to this union are John Paul, Janetta Fay, and Gerold. W. Paul, son of Frank and Edna Graham and brother to Frank Edward. W. Paul Graham is a Baptist Minister, graduate of Sallisaw High School and Oklahoma Baptist University at Shawnee, Oklahoma. There he received his Bachelor Of Arts Degree and served as President of the Ministerial Alliance, an organization comprised of 150 ministerial students. At the present time (1972) he is pastor of the Second Baptist Church at Ponca City, Oklahoma.

 Golda Milton Stephens born October 18, 1910, in Sequayah County, Sallisaw, Oklahoma to Marion Addison and Bertie Elnora Stephens. On December 15, 1925, she married Fred Lee Harlen Jameson born March 19, 1907 in Crawford County, Rudy, Arkansas. Son of James Clinton and Minnie Ellen (Horn) Jameson. Clinton and Minnie born and married in Arkansas. Fred and Golda have lived in Hutchenson, Kansas for many years and now live at 1718-North Van-Buren, Hutchenson, Kansas 67501. Golda is a seamstress and Fred a lineman for Bell Telephone Company for the past 42 years. Three children born to this union are James Earl, Marion Merle, and one died at birth.

 James Earl Jameson born a twin to Marion Merle on July 17, 1927, sons of Fred L. H. and Golda Milton Jameson. James E. grew up and completed high school in Hutchenson, enlisted in the United States Navy in 1944, serving one year and two months at Guam as store keeper first class. He attended Jr. College at Hutchenson 1946-1948, Midwestern Bible College, Attumwa, Iowa 1950-1952, University of Colorado, Denver,

one year 1956-1957. James Earl is a ordained minister. Present (1972) occupation is Industrial Pacyhologist at Denver. Married Verla Pollet, daughter of Lewis P. and Ruth Gladys Pollet. Lewis P. born January 23, 1901, Cozad, Nebraska, (Bohemian). Ruth Gladys also born at Cozad on July 8, (Scotch Irish).

Verla, after finishing high school took Radio Electronic in 1945--Nebraska Teachers College--1946-1947--Manhattan Bible College 1947-1948, and Church of Midwestern Bible College, Ottumwa, Iowa 1948-1950. Verla now (1972) is employed as Assistant Secretary with Sheridan Savings and Loan, Denver, Colorado. Three children born to this union are Monica Sharee, born October 30, 1950, Ottumwa, Iowa, Linda Renie born May 29, 1954, Scotts Bluff, Nebraska, and Francine Meschelle born December 14, 1956, Colorado Springs, Colorado.

Monica Sharee Jameson married a minister's son at Ottumwa, Iowa where she was going to school. baby Anthony James born Feb=1973

Marion Merle Jameson born July 17, 1927, twin brother to James Earl and son Fred Lee Harlen and Golda Milton Jameson. Married Helen Sarras August 11, 1950. Helen was born March 23, 1929, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, daughter of Lewis Sarantopoulous Sarras (Greek) and Claudia Lee Isabelle Sarras (Irish). Their two girls are Janet Merle born May 15, 1951 at Oklahoma City, and Lynn Ellen born April 19, 1954, also at Oklanoma City. In 1972 both girls were in college and their mother was teaching.

Marion M. grew up and finished high school in Hutchenson, Kansas. Joined the United

States Navy and was store keeper on Guam, Saipan and Tinian until discharged July 1946. He graduated from the Jr. College at Hutchenson, Kansas, entered the Nazarene College at Bethany, Oklahoma January 1949 and graduated in 1950 with B.S. Degree, he had previous experience with grocery chain stores and accepted a position as General Merchandising Specialist for new stores with the Independent Grocers Alliance and for the next four years traveled thorough out the state of Oklahoma.

Marion finally decided the teaching profession would permit him to utilize better his many experiences and contribute more to the betterment of young people. He began teaching in Oklahoma City in 1956 and taught for the next few years there while he continued his education in the summers under National Science Foundation Scholarship. He studied biology in 1956 at Southern Methodist University, Dallas, Texas, mathematics in 1957 at Central State College, Edmond, Oklahoma, geology in 1958 at Colorado College, Colorado Springs, Colorado, astronomy 1959 at Carleton College, Northfield, Minnesota, received a fellowship to study advanced space science at Franklin Institute, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania in 1963, and has studied at the National Aeronautics Space Administration Center, Houston, Texas. As he taught in Oklahoma City he worked part time at grocery stores to help with living expenses until he found he could make as much assisting weekends at the art center planetarium there, this experience made him the logical choice to be to be the first full time director of the facility in 1960 and he left the teaching profession for a time. He remained the director and studied at the Oklahoma

University for his Masters Degree which he received in 1965. Returned to Hutchenson, Kansas to supervise construction of the planetarium at the Junior College there, 1966 came to Olivet College to supervise construction of the planetarium, as it's director and as assistant professor of physical science. Aside from his regular daytime science teaching schedule has an evening astronomy class at the college, teaches a weekly class in the adult education program for Kankakee School District and is available as a lecturer nights and weekends. Marion likes to travel, with a current goal to visit planetarium facilities in Europe and Eastern Countries in hope of determining what relationship exists, if any, between their technological advances and their educational processes. On religion, he said, "I think there is a faith that is common to all men and I like to emphasize this". Marion Merle and family live at Kankakee, Illinois, and is director of the \$227,000 Reed Planetarium at Olivet Nazarene College.

 Bessie Stephens born about 1905 near Sallisaw, Oklahoma, daughter of Marion Addison and Bertie Elnora Stephens married a Mr. Robertson, no children, lives at 321-South Cedar Street, Sallisaw, Oklahoma.

 Obed James Stephens born December 25, 1914, Sequayah County, Oklahoma son of Marion Addison and Bertie Elnora Stephens married Nola Mae Harrison 1938 in Sallisaw. Parents of one son Larry Keith, born December 11, 1941. Obed and Nola divorced in 1945. Obed married Lillian Ella Farmer at Fort Smith, Arkansas in 1946. They have no children. They moved to Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Their address now is 2751-West

Eubanks. Obed is maintenance engineer for Investment Henry Miller Company and has worked for them for several years.

Larry Keith Stephens born December 11, 1941, son of Obed J. and Nola Mae Stephens married Leota Mae Fletcher. They are parents of four daughters, Connie Sue born June 2, 1961, Shelley Ann born July 30, 1962, died in 1963, Jeannie Lynn born October 18, 1967, and Sherrell Ann born December 18, 1968. Larry K. and Leota Mae divorced and Larry married Carole Jeannine Petree in 1972.

 Bessie Rosetta Temple born February 21, 1886, Crawford County near Rudy, Arkansas, daughter of James Milton and Mary Elizabeth Temple married Oscar Jarome Lamb March 17, 1904. Oscar was born March 4, 1881 Crawford County son of Moses Lafayette and Louraine Lamb. Oscar J. raised on the farm and after marriage owned and operated a farm three miles east of Cedarville, Arkansas for sixteen years. Then moved to Van Buren and farmed in the Arkansas River bottom for 19 years. Oscar died in 1954 and Bessie died February 28, 1965, was buried in the Grace Lawn Cemetery near Van Buren. Oscar and Bessie were both members of the Methodist Church. Two children: Frank Milton and Stella May. Frank Milton Lamb born October 8, 1910, son of Oscar J. and Bessie R. Lamb married Lillian Blanch Jones on June 27, 1941. Lillian was born on February 28, 1918 in Sabastain County Greenwood, Arkansas, daughter of Robert and Mary Jones. Frank M. served two years in the United States Army during World War II, did overseas service in Italy under General Richard C. Sanders in Company 2265th O.M. Truck Co. Discharged March 13, 1946 at Fort Chaffee

Mr. Madden was known by the family as James Madden. James Dunbar Madden. I have a copy of his parole showing he was listed as J. M. Madden and he signed his name as M. Madden. Some time after 1865, they left TN, and came to Jasper Co., Carthage, MO, and later to Crawford Co., AR, near Cedarville. The trip from TN to AR was made in part or all in a ox wagon. Lemay's XXI Bomber Command to strike regularly at the heart of Japan's war industry. Sergeant King was a radio mechanic in a service unit commanded by Brigadier General Emmett O'Donnell Jr. who led the first B-29 striking force from Saipan to bomb Tokyo's aviation industry on Nov. 24, 1944. The work of Sergeant King and his fellow soldiers was directly responsible for the success of the B-29's in bombing Japan's war industries. General O'Donnell

said in congratulating them "these men realize their responsibilities in the pre-mission tasks of insuring the maximum chance of safe return of the air crews. Without the spirit of teamwork which has been exhibited by every man, our pioneering job, which is only beginning, could not of been a success. They have given their services fully and in complete disregard for personal comforts and pleasure in lieu of hard work and long hours". Additional tribute has been paid Sergeant King and the others for their toil in constructing their B-29 bases. And since aviation engineers were busy with the high priority task of airstrip building, they constructed homes for themselves and for the aerial combat crews who arrived later.

Samuel King after being discharged from the service entered the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, AR, Jan. 1946 where he received his Bachelor of Science, Master of Science Degrees. 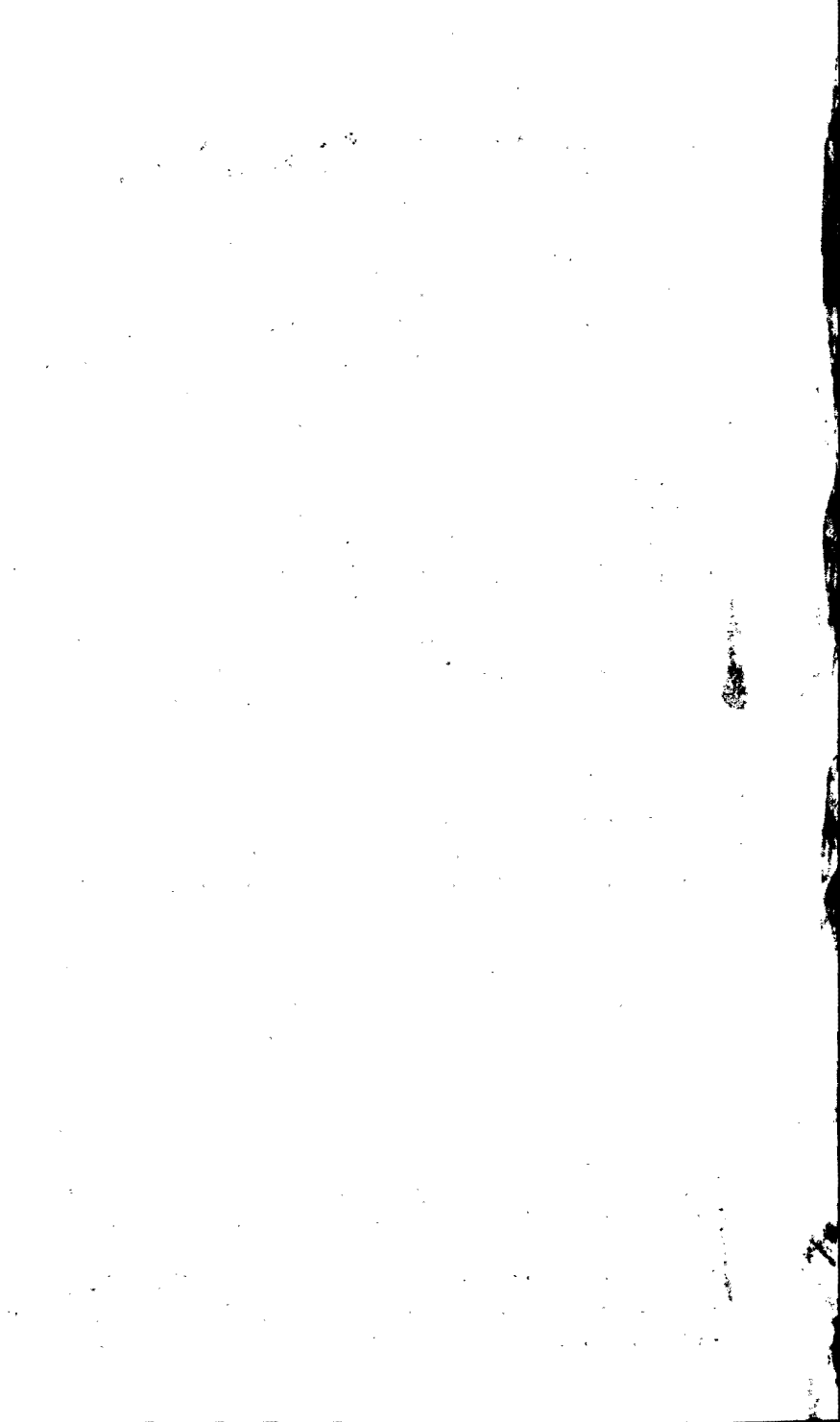

This will show some of the decendants of John Pryor. There are several John Pryors. The early Pryor settlers was in the 1600. The Pryors were very famous and considered wealthy in that day. More history of the Pryors can be obtained from a book being written. (Pryors in America) by Vera Jane (Pryor) Alker, 3415-P Street N. W., Washington, D.C. 20007. A cousin to the wife of the writer of this book (Elmer E. Temple).

John Pryor born about 1750 probably in PA, married Margaret Garvin when she was about 16 years of age. The 11 children born to this union are: John Jr., Samuel, Isaac, William, Sarah, Robert, Luther, Nathan, Joshua, James, and Hanna.

In 1801 John Sr. and Margaret Pryor moved from Greene Co., PA, to Belmont Co., OH, where he took up his claim to a large tract of land lying along the Captina Creek. Later they sold off several tracts of land and finally settled in section 35 of Smith Township, where the old Pryor house is still standing (1970) but has not been lived in for several years. John Pryor Sr. was killed Oct. 1825 during a horse race, the horse ran off the track and under a low tree limb that knocked him off his horse and killed him instantly, he must have been 70 years of age or more.

Hanna Pryor born Apr. 6, 1800, daughter of John Sr. and Margaret Pryor married Elisha Lucas Apr. 17, 1823.

John Brown Pryor born Feb. 25, 1819 in Ohio, son of Robert and Jemima Pryor, married Lavenia Huffman Mar. 5, 1840 in Washington Co., OH. They had three children: George W., Margaret, and Jemima Ellen.

George W. Pryor born Mar. 11, 1841, Monroe Co., OH, son of John Brown and Lavenia Pryor, George served throughout the Civil War in the Union Army. He married America J. Speer in 1866. They had several children in MO.

Some Sketches of History on the Rozells

The family of Rossell is of Danish origin and derives its name from one of the fiefs which they possessed anterior to the conquest of England. The village and lordship of Le Rozel are in the department of La Manche, in Normandy, about a mile from the sea coast; these records begin about 760.

John Rossell was one of the first to come from England to the U.S. He was an officer in Cromwell's Army; he was born about 1633. He married Mary Johnson, at London in 1668. He came to America after his marriage and settled at Newtown, NY.

Zachariah Rossell, Esq., who may be considered the founder of the family in the U.S. and who was its head from 1776 to 1815, was born at Bayrstown, NJ, married, first, Mrs. Margaret (Clark) Curtis, in 1759.

There is quite a history of the Rossells up to about 1890, written by Prof. Clifford S. Sims, Historical Society of PA, but it will not be included in this book. We are interested in another line branched off some where, early Rossell or Rozells were notable, prominent, and wealthy.

A Mr. William Morse Rozell married Polly Barnes, sometimes called Mary, probably her name was Mary Polly Barnes, on Apr. 3, 1797, Rockingham Co., NC. There is a Mrs. Marie T. Simrell from the Rozell family also working on this line. Her address is Mrs. Marie T. Simrell, Route 2, Box 148, Pinson, AL 35126. We don't have definite proof but records lead us

to believe that it is true, we are trying to prove that William Morse Rozell is the father of the sons and daughters listed below:

Talcum has been the minister of Short Oklahoma Baptist Church the past 19 years, is retiring next year (1974). They live at Star Route, Uniontown, AR 72955. Peter Temple was born about 1750 in Prince George County, Virginia, and died in 1808 in Hancock County, Georgia. In about the year 1776 he married Nancy Epps, who was born about 1758 in Prince George County, Va. and died on June 2nd 1823 in Hancock County, Georgia. In all Parish records and in nearly all court records she is called "Nancy", while in the census records of 1820 and on her Tombstone inscription, she is called "Ann", of course, "Nancy" was a nickname for "Ann". She is buried in the City Cemetery, Sprata, Hancock County, Georgia. Where her grave is marked with a heavy Granite slab bearing a small oval-shaped marble plate in the center of the slab, it contains the following inscription: "Ann Temple" died June 2nd 1823. (it does not contain the date of her birth.) during the American Revolution, Peter Temple served for at least eighteen months in Captain Felix Warley's Company, 3rd South Carolina Regiment, commanded by Colonel William Thompson, and was present at the siege of Charleston. Records of the War Department show that he received pay for his service in the year 1779. His name also appears on a payroll of the 3rd South Carolina Regiment for march in Garrison, 1780, which shows the regiment was in Garrison at the siege of Charleston in the year of 1780. On July 20th 1787, he received a grant of 344 acres in Prince George County, Virginia. (Land Grants by the commonwealth of Virginia. Book 12, page 282). On march 2nd 1789, he received a grant of 100 acres in South Carolina, for his Revolutionary service, although he did not settle there. (Bounty Grants to Revolutionary Soldiers, Office of the

Secretary of State of South Carolina, Volume 4, page 529.) Numbers 363 and 364, Book P, South Carolina Historical Commission, state that Peter Temple was a brother of Jacob Temple, who also served in the same regiment in the American Revolution. An instrument recorded in Prince George County, Virginia, clearly identifies these two Brothers in South Carolina as being from Prince George County, Virginia. It is a power of Attorney dated April 3rd 1786, and signed by Jacob Temple and his wife Mary (widow of Samuel Lee), giving power of Attorney to Henry Williams, in referring to Jacob Temple, the instrument states that he is "now living in South Carolina", witnesses were Peter Temple, and Jones Bonner. (Prince George County, Virginia. Deed Book, 1787-1792 Part 1, page 26,) Peter Temple lived in Prince George County, Virginia, until the year 1793, and served as Vestryman in the Church. (Bishop Meade; Old Churches, Ministers and families of Virginia, Volume 2 Page 176). He was a tax-payer in Prince George County, Virginia, for the year 1793 and earlier years, but after that year was a tax-payer in Hancock County, Georgia. The birth of Peter Temple's daughter, Candace, is recorded in the parish records of Bristol Parish, Virginia. Churchill Gibson Chamberlyne, The Vestry Book and Register of Bristol Parish, Virginia, page 379, lists: "Candace daughter of Peter Temple and Nancy his wife, born July 18th 1792 and baptized January 4th 1793," After the death of Peter Temple in Hancock County, Georgia. Nancy Temple was appointed on Dec. 10th 1803, guardian of the property of Candace Temple, orphan of Peter Temple, deceased. (Hancock County, Georgia. Minute Book, 1799-1817, page 115.) This clearly identifies Peter, Nancy and Candace Temple with both Prince George County, Virginia. and Hancock County, Georgia.

Peter Temple died in 1802 in Hancock County, Georgia. His widow was Ann ("Nancy") Temple, and the administrator of his estate was Benjamin Temple (Hancock County, Georgia. Ordinary's Record, Volume AAAA page 122, 132; Volume L, page 122, 123: Minutes, 1799-1817, pages 51, 60, 71). Benjamin Temple was appointed administrator of the estate of Peter Temple on April 24th 1802. Inventory and appraisement estate of Peter Temple, late, deceased, April 26th 1802, Benjamin Temple, administrator, Thompson Bird, John Turner, James Shakesford, appraisers (Ordinary's Record, Volume L, page 122). 1820 Census, Hancock County, Georgia, Volume 2, page 88, lists; Ann Temple. Females; under 10; 1 16-25; 1 over 45; 1
P The last will and testament of Nancy Temple, dated October 24th, 1822,

I received a letter from Mrs,Lyndon B.Johnson June 8th 1976, stating that George Myrick,Mrs,Johnson's maternal great grandfather married Nancy Mason Temple, October 1833 in Autauga County,Alabama.Nancy Temple daughter of Benjamin and Jency Temple, born October 18th 1814 in Alabama died October 28th 1892 in Alabama.

There is a possibility that there could be a connection made with the English line which I have quite a record , if some one had the time and money (and don't forget that it takes lots of time and money to do this kind of work) I have spent about all the money I care too, as my health and age will not permit me to what I would like too.

The English record goes back to 586 A.D. The Temple line was known as de Temple until about 1490 A.D. when the "de" was droped and the name became "Temple".
