## THE NAME AND FAMILY OF DAVID(S)

The surname DAVID or DAVIDS is, in somecases, of Welsh origin. It was first used as a baptismal name and was later adopted as a patronymic by the sons of those so called. The addition of the final <u>s</u> indicates the suffix "son" and is the genitive form. The name <u>David</u>, supposedly of Hebrew deriviation, means "Beloved". The surname was also used in early times by the French, many of the original emigrants of the name to American having been of Huguenot descent.

It is interesting to note that surnames were not in general use in Wales until the early sixteenth century, some time after they had been accepted in England. The name appears in ancient British and early American records in the various spellings of Daffud, Daffyd, Dafyd, David, Davit, Davitt, Davitts, Davits, Davyd, Davydd, Davidd, Davyds, Davides, Davide, Davids, David, and many more. Of the forms mentioned the last is that most frequently in evidence in America Today, while that immediately preceding it is also in general use.

Families bearing this name were resident at an early period in the Welsh Counties of Cardigan, Pembroke, Flind, Clamorgan, and Carmarthen, and in the English Counties of Herford, York, Norfolk, Cambridge, Oxford, and London. They were, for the most part, of the landed and yeoman classes of the British Isles.

Edwyn ap (son of) Gronwy, King of Tegeingle, in Flintshire, Wales, was living in the tenth century A.D. He was the father of Owain, father of Llewelyn, the father of Ryryd. The last had a son named Madog Doy, who was the father of Griffith, father of Llewelyn Coch, who had a son named Llewelyn Vychan. David, son of Llewelyn Vychan, was the father by his wife, Gruffyd Lloyd, of Benet, who was the father of another David, who had issue by his wife Elizabeth of a son named John. This John was the father by his wife Gwen of William, Robert, Edward, Elis, John, Pyrs, Mari, and Gras, surnamed Davids.

Of these, William Davids married Marget, daughter and heir to Thomas Arudel, Esq., and was the father by her of John, Raplael, and Edward Davids, of Whitford, Flintshire.

Another Flintshire line of the family was represented in the early sixteenth century by David ap Griffith, a descendant of Bleddyn ap Kynvyn, who was living in Flintshire in the fourteenth century. David ap Griffith married Anghard, daughter of Edward Lloyd, and was the father by her of John and Ievan, of whom the former married Jane, daughter of Thomas Salisbury, of Leadbrook and had issue by her of Robert, John, and Katrin Davids. Of these, John was the father of a son named Edward; while Robert married twice. By his first wife, Katrin, daughter of George Ravenacroft, he was the father of Robert, Thomas, John, and Dorthy Davids, of whom the first was the father in the year 1617 by his wife, Ann Haynes, of a son named Robert; and by his second wife, Elizabeth, daughter of George Lother, the first-mentioned Robert Davids had issue of Lywk or Luce and Katrin or Katherine.

Among the other early Welsh lines of the name are those of Llwyn David, of the latter sixteenth century, who was probably the son of Rys, son of Gruffydd Lloyd, son of Morus, son of David of Cardiganshire; those of Owen or Ieuan David, of the latter sixteenth century, who was the son of David, a descendant of an extremely ancient lie in Carmathenshire; those of Jevan David, of the latter sixteenth century, who was the father of David, Gwenllian, Ethiw, and Mavefus, and the son of Daffudd, son of Ieuan, son of Thomas, son of Iewerth, son of Kynvrig, son of Kydwgan, son of Ieuan, son of Rys, son of Aron, son of Sir Iestyn, son of Ynyr, son of Gwrgenah, son of Gwrgenean, son of Idnuth, son of Kydwgen, son of Elystan Blodrydd, of Pembrokeshire; and those of Hugh David of the latter sixteenth century, who is thought to have been the son of David, son of Robert, son of Thomas, Son of Llewelyn, son of Cwain or Owen.

Among the earliest records of the name in England are those of one Dvitt,

of County Norfolk, in the year 1273; Godfrey Davit, of Oxfordshire, at a slightly later date; "Dauid, Walschman", of Yorkshire, in 1379; one David and his wife Alice of Alicia, or Yorkshire, about 1379; and Mauryce or Maurice David, of London, who married Sarah Ivatt in 1578.

Bernard de David, who was living at Saint Jean D'Acre, France, as early as the year 1250, was the progenitor of the family of the name at Lastoure. Of this line was Amelius David, living in 1280, who was the father of a son of the same name, who had issue of two sons, Pierre (Peter) David and Geoffrey David. Of these, Pierre married Agnes de Laage and was the father by her of Pierre David, who married Marguerite Audiere. To this union was born Etienne David, Lord of Vantaux, near Limoges.

Another French line traces its descent from Claude David, who was living in 1431 in the city of Saline. His grandsons, Guy and Jean David, were prominent in the public affairs of the nation. Bertrand, a descendant of Guy, was secretary to the king. He married Marie Joly in 1689 and was the father by her of Claire David.

Jean Davy, ancestor of the family of the name of David at Perdrequbille, France, was married in 1450 to Catherine Bataille. Their son, Jacques David, resided at Perdreauville and was the father by his wife, Jeanne duPlessis, of a son named Nicolas, Lord of Meretz. The last married Ann D'Allenes in 1530 and was the grandfather of Jean David, Lord of Perdreauville, who was married in 1591 to Denise Boscher. To the last-mentioned union were bord Phillippe, Alphonse, and others.

Among the earliest emigrants of the name to America were several who settled in Virginia. These included John David, of Elizabeth City County, in 1635; Evan David, of the Isle of Wight County, in 1641; and Willia David, who came over about (William David) (?) 1648, but whose place of settlement is not known. None of these early colonists left any definite record of their immediate families or descendants, if any.

In the year 1649, if not before, John David made his home at Boston, Mass., but his personal records are incomplete. It is possible, although there is no proof, that Samuel Davids, who was living at Boston, Mass., before 1663, was closely related to the last-mentioned immigrant.

Numerous records of the name were to be found at early dates in New York, chiefly at Tarrytown, and it is considered porbable that these families were of Dutch, German, or French Huguenot ascestry. Among these settlers were Mathys or Matheus Davids, who was the father in the year 1679 by his wife Debora of a son named David; Kendrick or Henry Davids, about 1732, who was the father by his wife, Annatie Van Tessel, of Helena, Catharina, Zarel, Annatie, and Marittie; Joost Davids, before 1733, who was the father by his wife, Annakaor Annatie Ackerman, of Jannitie, Loodewyck or Ludwig, Hiellegontie, Maritie, Thomas, Willem or William, and possibly other children; Willem or William Davids, about 1735, who was the father by his wife, Nellet je Storms, of Willem, Charles, David, Zarel, and Esther; as well as numerous others of later dates, many of whom were inter-related.

David Davids, of Westchester Count, N.Y., son of William and Penelope (Nellet je?) Storm or Storms Davids, was married about the middle of the eighteenth century to Jane, daughter of Captian Abraham Hatfield, of White Plains, N.Y. He had at least two sons, Abraham and David Davids; and his will dated 1781, mentions his brother's two sons, William and John Davids (probably sons of Charles Davids, of Tarrytown).

Sometime before 1712 one Pierre (later recorded as Peter) David, a Huguenot, made his home in King William Parish, Va. His records are not complete, but it is probable that he left issue.

Owen David, a Welshman, came to America in 1737 and settled in the Welsh Neck, on the Great Pee Dee River, in South Carolina. He was the grandfather of William J. David, of Marlboro County, S.C., who married Rebecca Spears and was the father of at least one son, Dr. John Hodges David, of Marion County, S.C.

About the middle of the eighteenth century John David, who was a French Huguenot, came to America and settled at Albany, N.Y. He appears to have been the grandfather of, probably among others, John and Barnabas Bradt David. Of these brothers, John made his home at Boston, Mass., and was the father by his wife, Luch Hollis, of John Oliver, Charles Henry, and Luch Ann, whose descendants are numerous both in Massachusetts and in New Hampshire.

Barnabas Bradt David, grandson of the immigrant John, resided at Amherst, N.H. He married Elizabeth Welsh Melendy, by whom he was the father of seven children, Edward Cornelius, Samuel Melendy, William Glenn, James Barnabas, Elizabeth Welsh, Albert Fitch, and Louisa Garaphelia, Of these, the first son removed to the Wyoming Territory; the second resided at Cambridge, Mass.; the third made his home in Jowa; and James resided at Somerville, Mass.

On the shole, the record of the families of David and Davids in America is that of an energetic, industrious, conscientious, and practical race. In certain lines they have displayed marked ability as musicians, while in others, they have been particularly outstanding in the fields of medicine, business, scholarship, and literature.

Among those of the name who served in the War of Revolution were Chaplin Ebenezer David, of Rhode Island; Job David, of New Hampshire; David Davids, of New Jersey; Charles, Henry, and Theodorus David, of Virginia; Michael David, of Kentucky; William David, of North Carolina; David, Abel, Adam, Elias, Henry Hugh, Issac, John Jonathan, Peter, and William David, of New York; David, Issac, John, William, Jonathan, and Captain David Davids, of New York; Benjamin, Eleayzer, James, John, Joshua, Miller, Phineas, Samuel, Thomas, and William David, of Penn.; Benjamin, Charles, Francis, Josiah Jr., Noah, Peter, and Sampson or Samuel David, of Massachusetts; Daniel Davids, of Massachusetts; and many more.

Thomas, William, David, Hugh, Owen, John, Samuel, Henry, James, Barnabas, Benjamin, Edward, George, and Charles are some of the Christian names favored by the Davids for their male Progeny.

Of the bearers of the name who have distinguished themselves in various parts of the world in more recent times, the following are considered representatives:

Laurent Oliver David (1840-1925), of Canada, author.

Thomas William Whys Davids (1843-1922), of England, Oriental scholar.

George Breckinridge David (b. 1847), of Mass., soldier and author.

John Hodges David (b.1856), of S.C., physician and manufacturer.

Vernon Cyrenius David (b. 1882), of Ill., surgeon.

Austin Banks David (b. 1883), of Georgia, banker.

Claude E. David (b. 1896), of Idaho, corporation official.
