## PREFACE

For some years the author has had in mind the project of preparing a history of the George Simpson family. This idea received stimulation from a bulletin published by the Washington County Historical Society in 1936 -- THE EDMISTONS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS, by Allen S. Humphreys. On page 10 of that publication is the statement of the family of George and Mary Ann Simpson with a list of their children but no further data. The present study carries the history of this family down to the present and it is hoped that it will be of interest both to the descendents of the George Simpson-Mary Ann Edmiston union and to others who care to know more about the Edmiston family. The author has received a great deal of satisfaction from making the study but has met with some problems which have been challenging.

Two methods of collecting information have been used. First, letters were written to a large number of the descendents for information about their particular branch of the family and many responded promptly. Some did not reply at all even after two or three requests. Many were able to give leads as to the location of other members of the family. Second, personal visits were made to several people who would have information about the family. It was found that even in the case of personal visits such data as dates of birth, death and marriage could not be recalled. This was particularly true of names and dates of spouses.

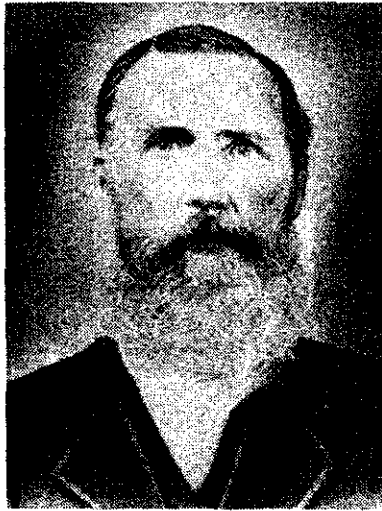
While it is not possible to list all who contributed to the study, there are a few who deserve particular mention because of the special assistance rendered. Perhaps the study would never have been started had it not been for the information collected by Lillie Kate Dodson, my sister, even before the Edmiston study was published. For years she had kept bits of information about the relatives all of which she turned over to me because her health did not permit her carrying on what she had started. Nola Stockton collected the information about the family of Mary T. Simpson Smith. Minnie Dye did the same for the Tom Simpson family as did Mabel Mackie for the Hattie Mae Simpson Mackie family. Maxine Cory and Maurice Hambrick did a lot to aid in the task and deserve credit for it. Mrs. Fannie Hearn, a sister of James L. Simpson's first wife, gave a great deal of assistance and we want to acknowledge it gratefully. Many others did much but the list would run well over a hundred if all were named. So to those we express our appreciation.

The outline of the family tree is incomplete in many cases and there are apt to be errors in the spelling of names since some of these were presented orally and in a few cases, even in the written records, different spellings were found. As mentioned above, dates gave considerable difficulty. Had more time been given to it perhaps a more complete and more accurate record could have been prepared.

The last part of the report consists of a few notes that are the recollections of the author and do not represent collected statements about the different families.

It is hoped that where errors occur, those concerned will accept them with kindness knowing that they are not intended.

## II NOTES

If there is such a thing as a typical American family that of George and Mary Ann Simpson would probably fall into such a classification. They started their home as farmer folk near Prairie Grove, Arkansas, in 1850. He was the son of Hugh and Jane Simpson and she the daughter of David Crawford and Rebecca Edmiston. Later, they moved to Cincinnati, Arkansas, where both died. They are buried in the Edmiston cemetery at Morrow, Arkansas

Could they view their descendents today they probably would be satisfied with what they would see. The family has remained substantially middle class with no outstanding achievements to its credit and no record of conviction of crime. Its members have been useful and respected citizens of the communities where they have lived. The tendency has been for the size of the family to decrease with later generations but there are a few who have had above the average number of children. As has been typical for the past three or four decades it has been a mobile family with great and great, great grandchildren scattered over most of the United States.

The youngest and only living child of George and Mary Ann Simpson is Mrs. Hattie Mackie who lives in Westville, Oklahoma. She and Lillie Kate Dodson, a granddaughter of George Simpson, are the ones to whom this production is dedicated.

The oldest child, Rebecca Jane Simpson, was married to Alfred Marrs at Prairie Grove, Arkansas, and they spent most of their married life as farmers near Westville, Oklahoma. For the most part their children have remained in Oklahoma, but George, the oldest son, moved to western Texas where his children are now located. John, another son, migrated to Oregon where he was married and spent most of his life. Jennie also moved to the West as did several of the grandchildren. Three of the daughters, Etta, Maggie and Ina, live at Westville, Oklahoma, and one son, Tom, lives at Stillwell, Oklahoma. The address of Jennie is not known to the author.

John, the oldest son, married Jane Marrs who was a sister of Alfred Marrs, the husband of Rebecca. They established their home near Prairie Grove, Arkansas, and reared their family. After her death, he married Cora Wilson and four children were born to this union. He kept the original Simpson farm near Prairie Grove until his death. One daughter, Amy, lives at San Carlos, California, and her twin sister, Alma, lives in Houston, Texas. Of the second family only one is living. He is John Simpson of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Like his brother John, Henry Simpson was married twice. The first time to Fannie Ross and to this union four children were born. There were no children by the second marriage to Sallie Dodson. Henry lived in Prairie Grove where he had farming and business interests. Mary, the daughter, lives in Locust Grove, Oklahoma, and the sons, Edward and Frank, live in Colorado.

James L. Simpson also was married twice, the first time to Mary Ellen Hill to whom all of his children were born. His second wife was Sarah Stout. He spent most of his married life as a farmer near Westville and Muskogee, Oklahoma. Only two of his children are living. Frank lives in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and Hattie in California.

Thomas Jefferson Simpson married Kate Russel near Westville, Oklahoma, and later moved to Chelsa, Oklahoma, where all of his children were reared. Here he developed extensive agricultural interests. The two remaining children, John and Minnie, live in or near Chelsa. Minnie Dye furnished most of the information about this family.

Mary T. Simpson married M. C. Smith and lived on a farm near Cincinnati, Arkansas,



until he retired as a farmer and stockman and moved to Siloam Springs, Arkansas. Although he was connected in one way or another with agriculture all his life, none of his sons followed farming as an occupation. The three living daughters reside in Arkansas, Gertrude in Fayetteville, Nola at Siloam Springs, and Hattie at Springdale. The author does not have at hand the addresses of the living sons.

Fannie Bell Simpson married J. R. Hambrick, a farmer, at Westville, Oklahoma, and to this marriage three sons were born all of whom are still living. Webster lives at Lander, Wyoming, Maurice at Cleveland, Oklahoma, and Lester at Pueblo, Colorado. It is believed that all of these are now or have been farmers.

Martha Irene Simpson married W. E. Bond and all their married life lived near Cincinnati, Arkansas, where they engaged in farming. They had two children. Lillie Kate married Homer Dodson and had one son who lives at Monticello, Arkansas. George William lives at Searcy, Arkansas.

George David Simpson, the youngest of the sons, was married twice, first to Dora Cabe, to whom all of his children were born, and later to Alice Woods. He engaged in farming all of his life near Cincinnati, Arkansas, and Westville, Oklahoma. None of his sons is engaged in farming and only one of the daughters lives on a farm. Mary Dona lives at Gentry, Arkansas, John Dee at Memphis, Tennessee, Sallie at Siloam Springs, Arkansas, George William at Tulsa, Oklahoma, and Joe at Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Walker is in the army and stationed at Fort Gordon, Georgia.

Elizabeth Annie Simpson married George Mackie and they engaged in farming in Oklahoma and near Cincinnati, Arkansas. They had two children both of whom live in Arkansas, Joe at Cincinnati and Irene at Fayetteville.

Hattie Mae Simpson, the youngest child, married John Mackie the brother of Elizabeth Annie Simpson's husband, George Mackie. Their married life was spent in farming near Westville, Oklahoma. Mable lives at Sand Springs, Oklahoma, and Polly at Tulsa. Anna lives at Odessa, Texas, and John at Snohomish, Washington.
