

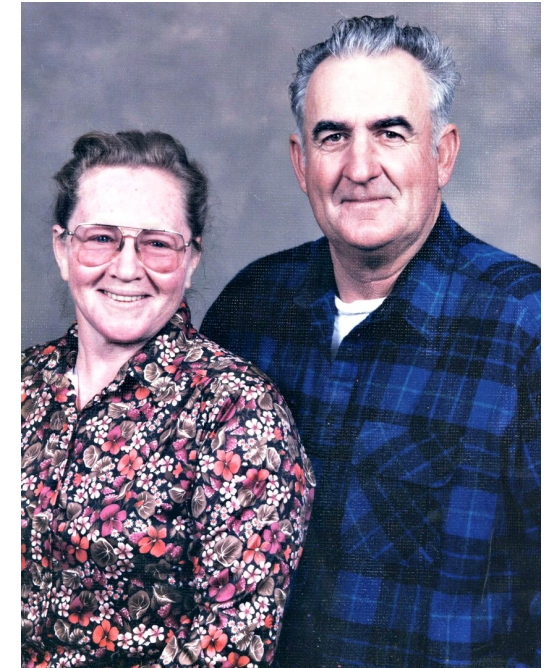
### **Gladys Loretta Beeks**
