

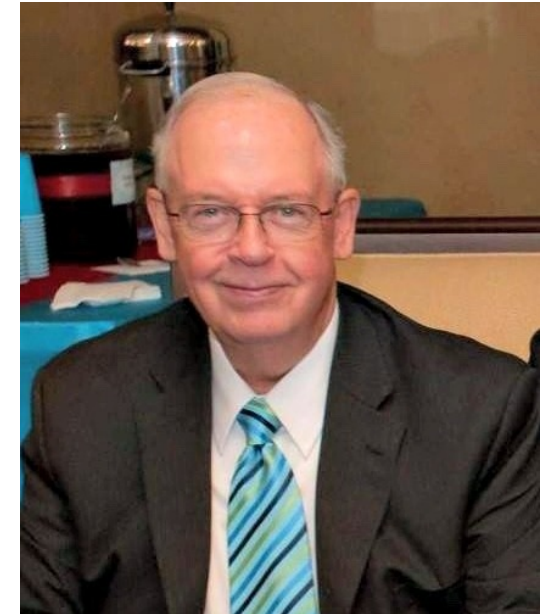
Larry Wayne Boone
