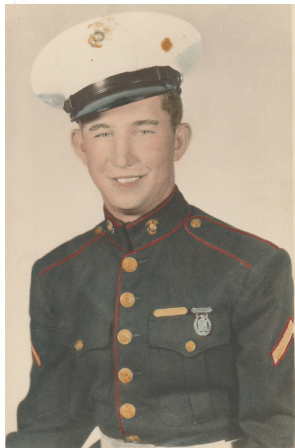


James Evans Brand Jr
