

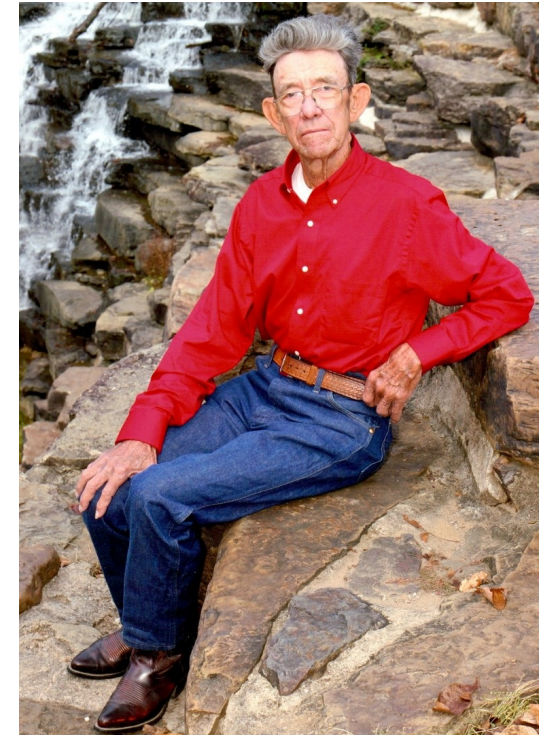
John William Calhoon
