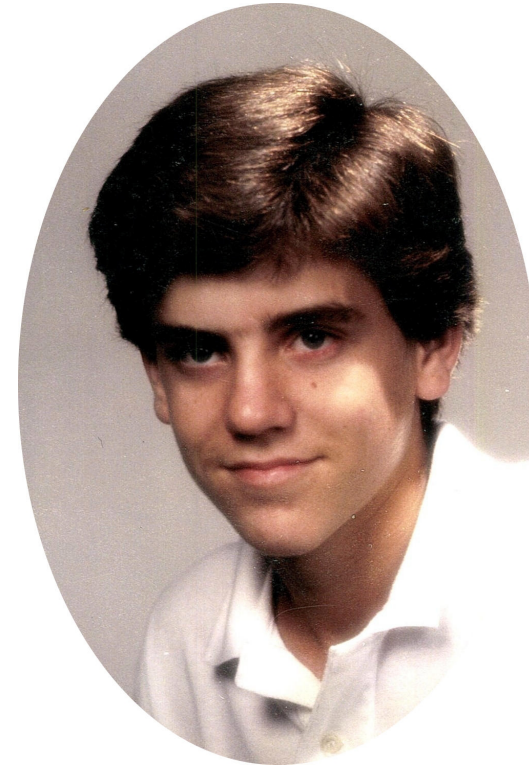
**Kerry Wade Carter**
