

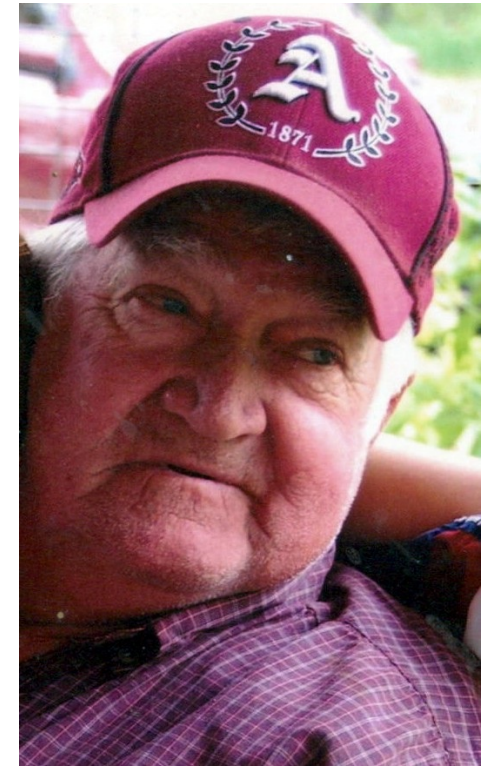
Richard Eugene Center
