

### **Noah A. Couch**

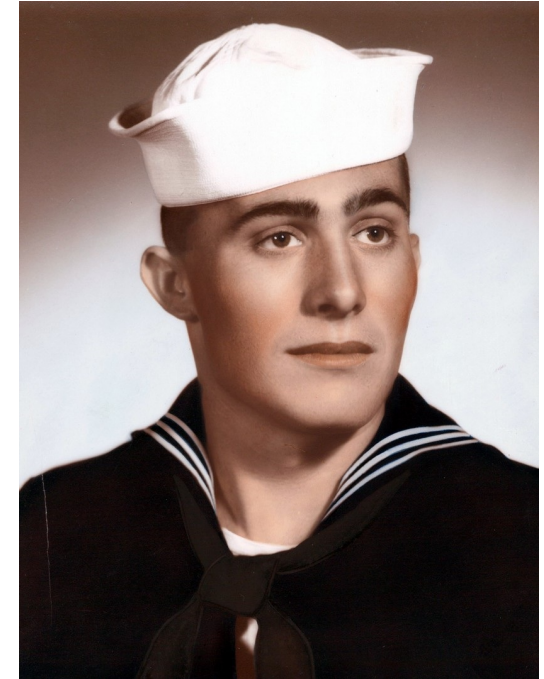
