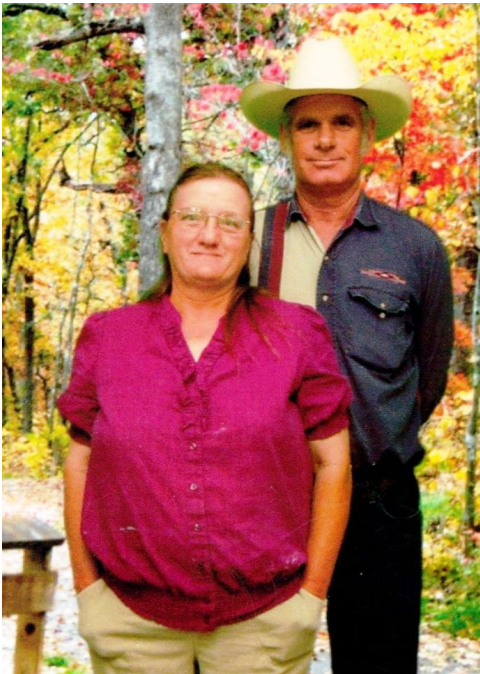


Sherry Sue Crawford
