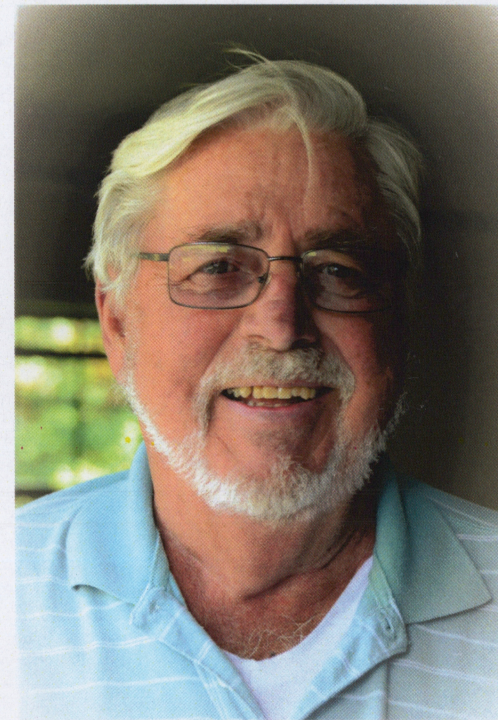
John was renowned for his unwavering loyalty, strong morals, and a deep sense of duty that shaped his life, love, and service.
