

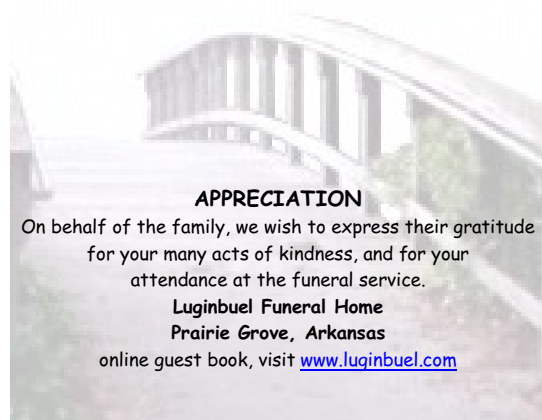
Carolyn Jean Dersam

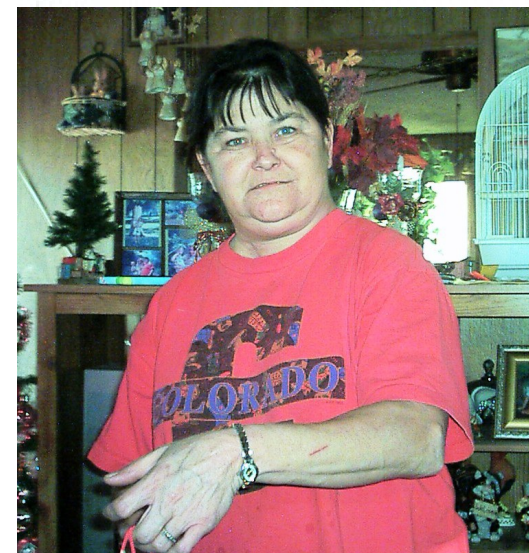
