## TWENTY THIRD PSALM

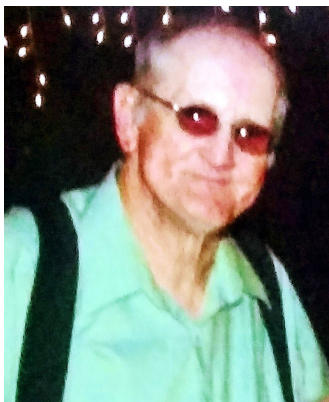
The LORD is my Shepherd;
