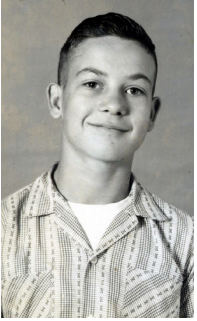

Denny Edgin
