

Edmund Eugene "Gene" Fitch

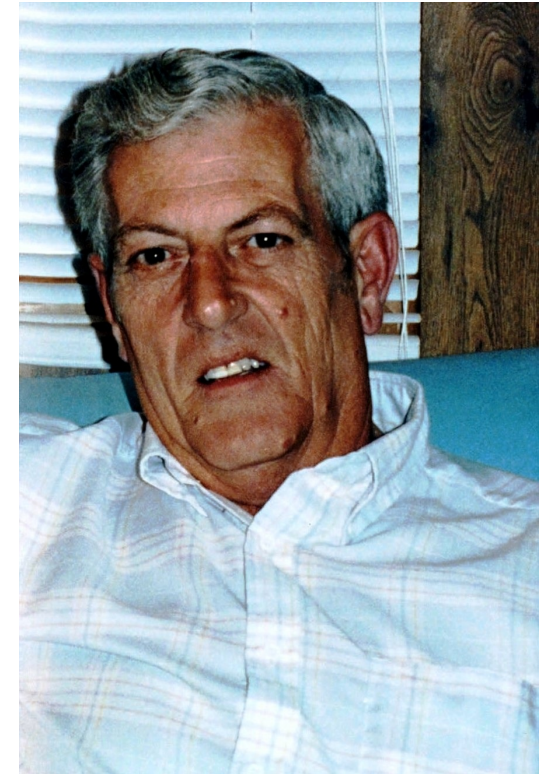
