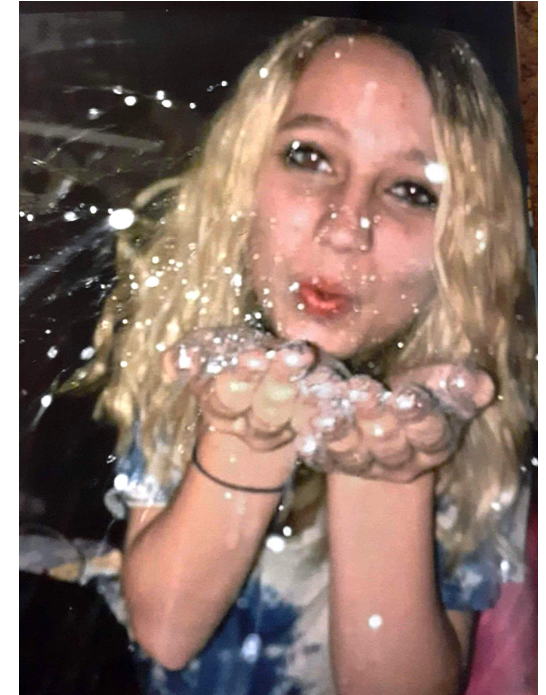


**Ari Lorraine Hankins**
