

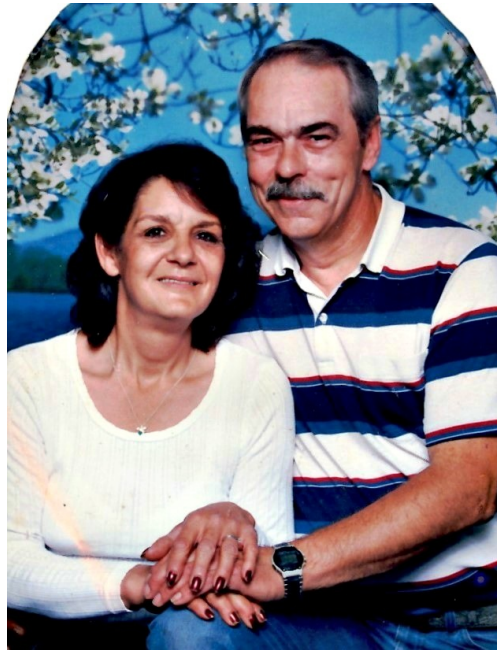
JD Hensley
