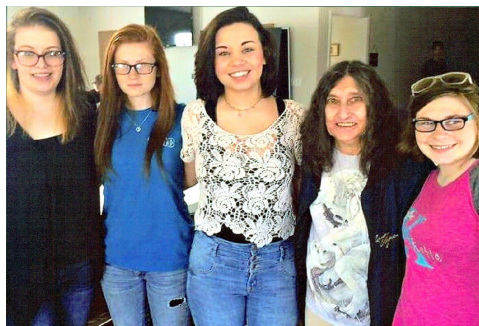


**Billie Ann Holiday**
