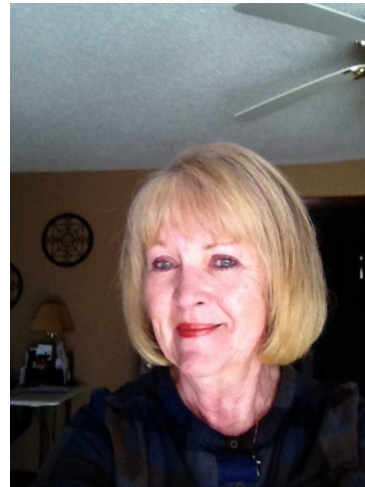
Darlis retired from the Lincoln School System after 30 years of service, spending most of her career working in Special Ed.
