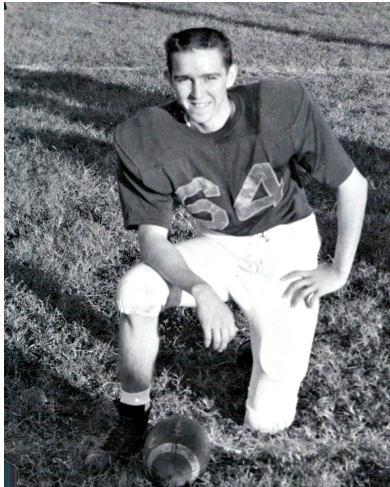


**Euel Gene Holloway**
