

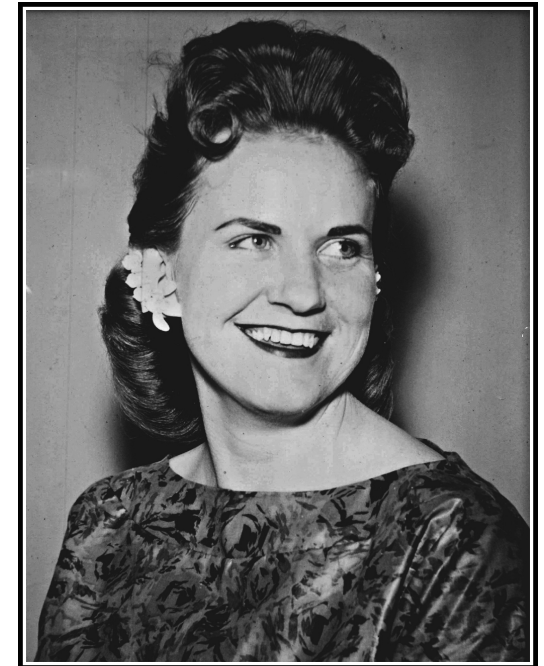
Maxine Elizabeth Henson King
