

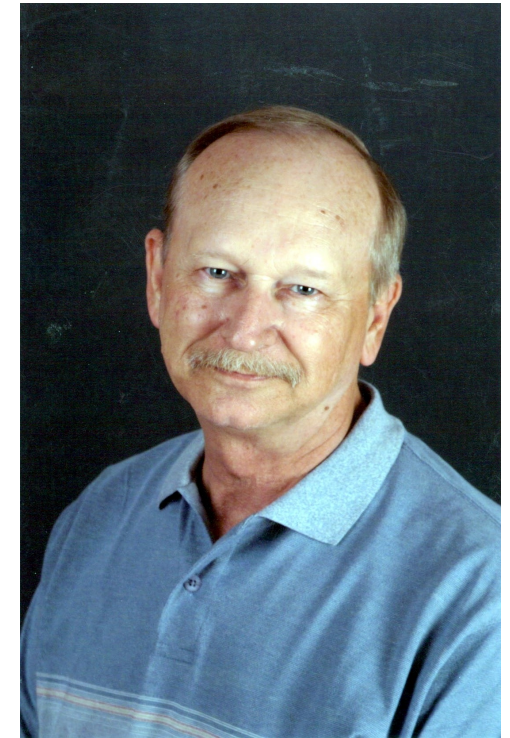
Larry Gene McFatrigh Sr.
