

Gregory Dale Samuels



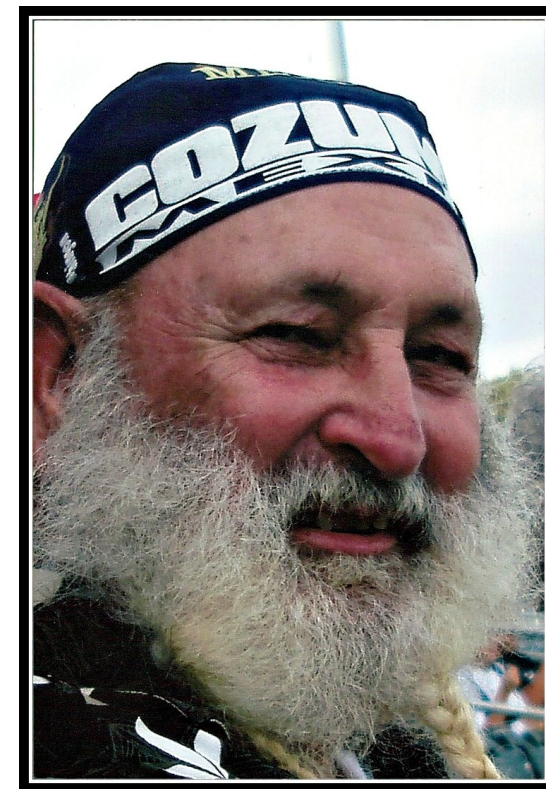
