

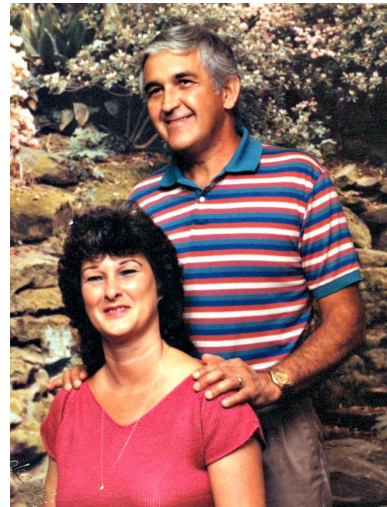
**Janie Ruth Buchanan Steele**
