

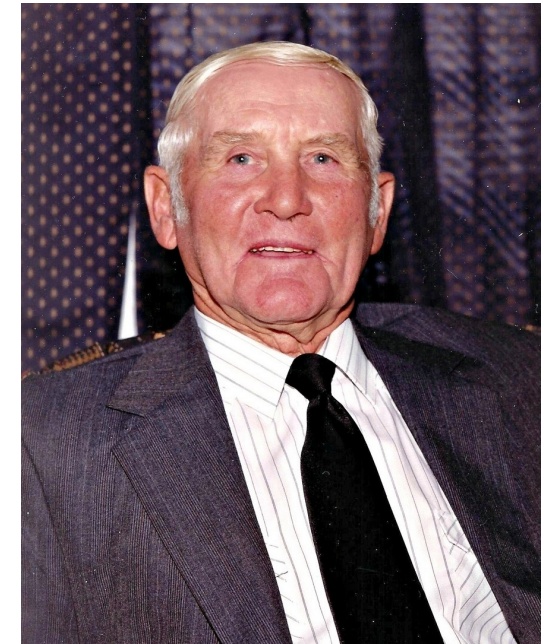
**Arthur "Travis" Villines**
