

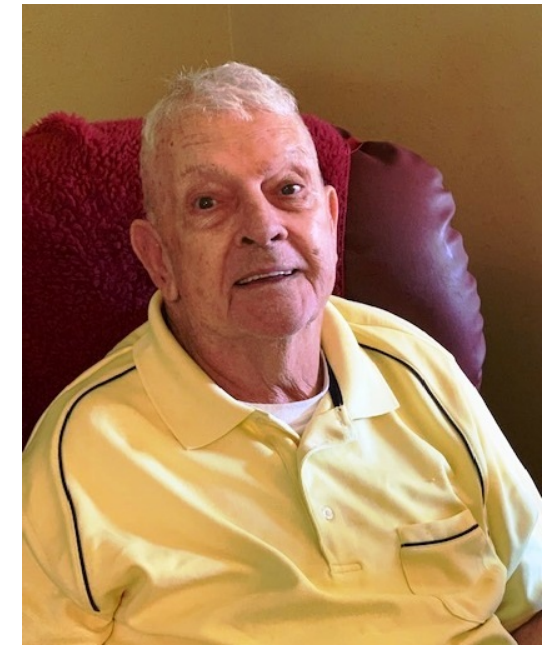
Robert Lee Wilhite
