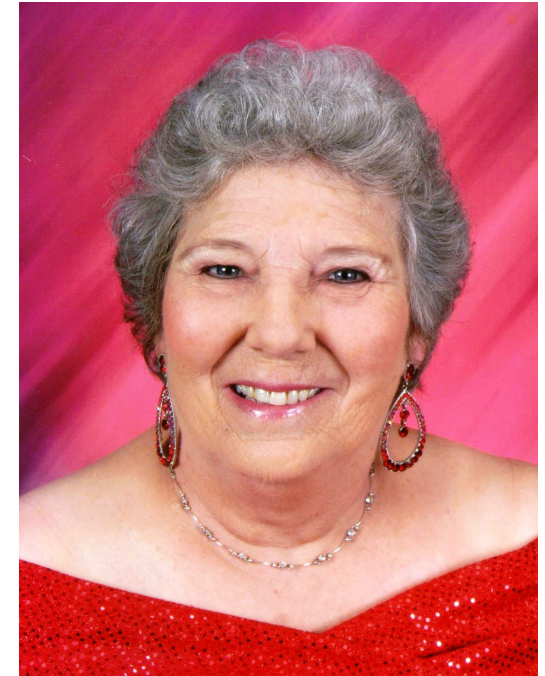


Frances Marcelle Wing
