General Rules

- 1) Before a grave is opened, a cemetery representative must be notified to confirm the plot location.
- 2) All grave opening shall be arranged thru Luginbuel Funeral Home (479) 846-2141.
- 3) The use of an Outer Burial Container (concrete box) is recommended.
- 4) Before the placement of a Headstone, a cemetery representative must be notified to confirm the plot location.
- 5) There will be no improvements made to the cemetery plot, except the headstone.
- 6) Planting of Trees, Shrubs, Flowers, Placement of Benches, Curbs, Walls, rocks, gravel or Fences of Any Description will not be allowed on the plot.
- 7) Foot stones or other markers must be at ground level.
- 8) Flowers must be in vases or secured on head stone, except during decoration.
- 9) You must have a permanent marker installed within six-months of burial.
- 10) We encourage you to make contributions for the upkeep of your cemetery.

Cremation Burial Policy

The following requirements pertaing to the burial of Cremated Remains:

- 1) One plot purchased at \$250.00 allows one burial, either casketed or cremated remains. Up to two (2) additional cremated remains may be buried on the same plot at no charge in the North 3 Section, North 2 Section and South 1 Section.
- 2) A maximum number of three burials per plot are permitted, one casket plus two cremated remains, or three cremated remains. Burial of cremated remains on the top of a casketed family member is permitted.
- 3) Burial of cremated remains by family members is permitted. Urn containers must be buried at least six inches below ground level to facilitate mowing.
- 4) All burials in a single plot shall be marked with a single permanent headstone containing the names of all persons buried in the plot.
- 5) Scattering of cremated remains ashes are not permitted on cemetery property.
- 6) A cemetery representative must be notified of any burial of cremated remains.
