RULES

There will be no improvements made to the cemetery plot, except the headstone. No fencing around the plot. No planting shrubs or any perennial flowers, they will be subject to mowing.

Foot stones or other markers must be at ground level except for headstone.

Flowers must be in vases, secured on head stone, except during decoration and two (2) weeks after.

Grave should be level after the ground settled.

Before a grave site is opened, it is requested that one of the Cemetery Association Trustees be contacted to verify location of the grave site. This will help avoid any possible misunderstanding.

You must have a permanent marker installed within a one (1) year period.

- 1) Effective January, 2001, all burial plots are \$100.00 each. Fees for plots may be paid in advance or at the time the grave is opened. Since such funds collected are applied to the cost of mowing and upkeep of the cemetery, payment at the time plots are reserved is required. WE ALSO NEED CONTRIBUTION FOR THE UPKEEP OF YOUR CEMETERY.
- 2) The Association cannot guarantee the exact location or size of the plots in the older section of the cemetery due to the passage of time when inaccurate records were kept. Alternate locations will be offered should any problems arise.
- 3) Making of plots reserved for future use is the responsibility of the person, or family, reserving them in order to ensure they are not mistakenly used by others. Prior to erecting a permanent head stone, a cement block shall be placed flush with the ground level so not to interfere with mowing the grass.
- 4) Plots cannot be resold or transferred without written consent of the Association Board.
- 5) Purchaser of the plot is responsible for proper location when the grave site is opened and when the permanent headstone is set.
- 6) All plots will be 5'x12'.
- 7) All plots will be in line in new part of the cemetery.
- 8) Your suggestions and contributions for the upkeep and care of your cemetery are encouraged.
- 9) Volunteer work at the cemetery is also encouraged.
- 10) Marking of plots reserved for future use is the responsibility of the person, or family, reserving them in order to ensure they are not mistakenly used by others. Prior to erecting a permanent head stone, a temporary marker, (a cement block) should be placed flush with the ground level so not to interfere with mowing of grass.
