## Guidelines & Maintenance

### 1. OFFICERS

### 2. RESERVING OF GRAVES

- Any person desiring to have a body or human remains interred in a grave shall contact one of the officers to receive a plot in the McDonald Cemetery.
- No body or human remains shall be interred within the McDonald Cemetery without the permission of the officers.
- The McDonald Cemetery is for the West Fork & surrounding area first and foremost, but those wishing to be buried in the McDonald Cemetery may purchase a plot for \$200, depending on availability.

### 3. CARE OF GRAVES

- No person shall erect any memorials on any grave except a footstone and a headstone. The planting of flowers and/or placement of benches are to be approved by the officers. The following are not allowed: planting of trees, shrubs, curbs, walls, rocks, borders, railings, wire-work, flower stands, ornaments or any other embellishments that will interfere with upkeep of the cemetery.
- Anything placed on or around or next to a grave or flowers or wreaths not in vases on the headstone that are still on a grave past the first Saturday in May may be removed by the officers and be destroyed or otherwise disposed of.
- You are welcome to decorate the graves any time and flowers may be placed on the grave any time. Flowers can be placed at the site at any time of the year. Any and all wilted flowers and obstructing decorations/ornaments will be removed and disposed of for you on the first Saturday in May.
- We encourage you to make contributions for the upkeep of your cemetery. This can be done by donating to the McDonald Cemetery.
