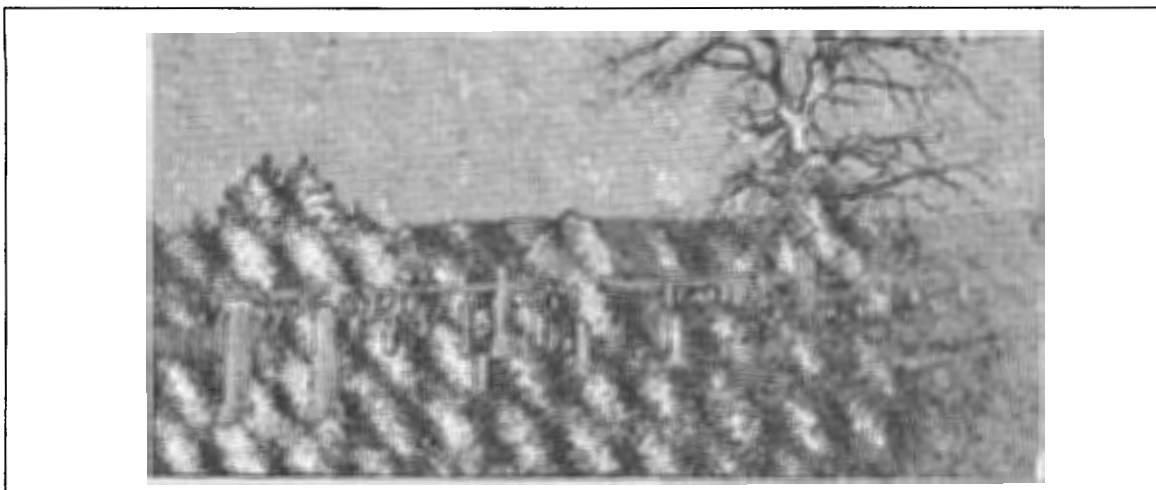
TO UPDATE OUR CEMETERY ROLL

Old Union

Cincinnati's Cemetery Since
July 1846 - Its Early History

The following report was written
by Mr. John H. Parks one of the
oldest and most respected citizens
of Illinois Township, & read by him
at an assembly gathered at the
old Cincinnati grave yard, for the
purpose of making arrangements
to clean the grounds and keep
them in permanent repair.

Nathan D. Hanks

Nathan D. Hanks, better known as "Brother Hanks," was an early day minister. He was much like the early day circuit rider only he made his circuit by walking. He lived at Lincoln, Arkansas, and walked to Cincinnati and surrounding areas to preach. He was a Presbyterian minister and would often stay overnight in the home of the people in his circuit. He ministered at weddings, burying the dead, and comforting those that needed him. He always carried his Bible and his violin. Many enjoyed his musical ability as well as his preaching.

JOHN HAMILTON PARKS

John H. Parks, often called, "Uncle John Parks," was born in Hopinsville, Kentucky, June 26, 1836. His father, Walter Davis Parks, born 1803, Virginia, brought his family to the Cincinnati area in 1849. He died shortly thereafter and was buried in "Old Union Cemetery," 1850.

John H. Parks was the fourth child in a family of eleven children. He was 14 years of age and took on much responsibility when his father died. He was educated at "The Cane Hill College." He was census enumerator in Washington Co. Ark., 1860. He was a soldier in the Civil War, serving in Co. B, 34th Inf., Ark. He was a Democrat. He was converted and joined the "Cumberland Presbyterian Church," at a young age. Later he was ordained "ruling elder" and held that office through his entire life.

He married Kate Gibson, September 20, 1860. To them was born four children, William Almer Parks, John James Parks, Walter Davis Parks, and Lizzie Dean Parks. All of these children were born and reared in this community. Most of this family is buried in "Old Union Cemetery."

John H. Parks died January 26, 1917, a caring man noted for his many kind deeds, among them, his caring for "Old Union Cemetery."

Report Given by John H. Parks, early 1900

Early History of "Old Union"
Cincinnati's Cemetery
Since July 1846

I was appointed to prepare & give a history of Old Union Graveyard.

The deed to the lot does not say anything about the graveyard so I will tell of "Union Meeting House"

The land was deeded to W^m Barclay, Geo Gibson, Thos West, Elijah Carter, & John Odle Trustees of Union Meeting House Lot, containing one acre.

The Citizens went to Illinois River and cut & Hewed Pine logs to build the house. It was seated with Stakes with holes bored to put logs in,

My Father moved to the Reagan place July 1849 Three yrs after the deed was made to the Church Lot. I have lived here ever since. There are only two persons now living who were grown when I came here. They are Mrs. Nathan West and Mr. Clem E. Clayton.

About 1852. the house was ceiled overhead by subscription.

About 1854th The Sons of Temperance seated the house with good seats, and soon after was weatherboarded by subscription.

The Good Templars ceiled inside walls in 1857

Soon after the War, some of the Citizens met in Cincinnati to elect trustees; as none of the old ones were living but one⁹ & he was not here. Those elected were

Wm. Paston Barclay, Daniel
B. Mason & John H. Parks Trustees
of Union Meeting House.

In 1872 the Citizens bought 2 A.
of land from Thos. P. Marquess:

It was deeded to Trustees above.
In 1886 Citizens wanted to fence
Union & Grave yd lots.

As the branch cut the Church lot
Marquess agreed to take all on
north side of branch & give us
land on east side of Graveyard.

The Trustees agreed to exchange.
The Church-house was put up
for sale to bidder, Mr. Sam Moore
got the house and the money
went to fence the lot.

I am only Trustee living. I hope
you will make new ones.

I have the deeds & will give them
to new Trustees. - John H. Parks

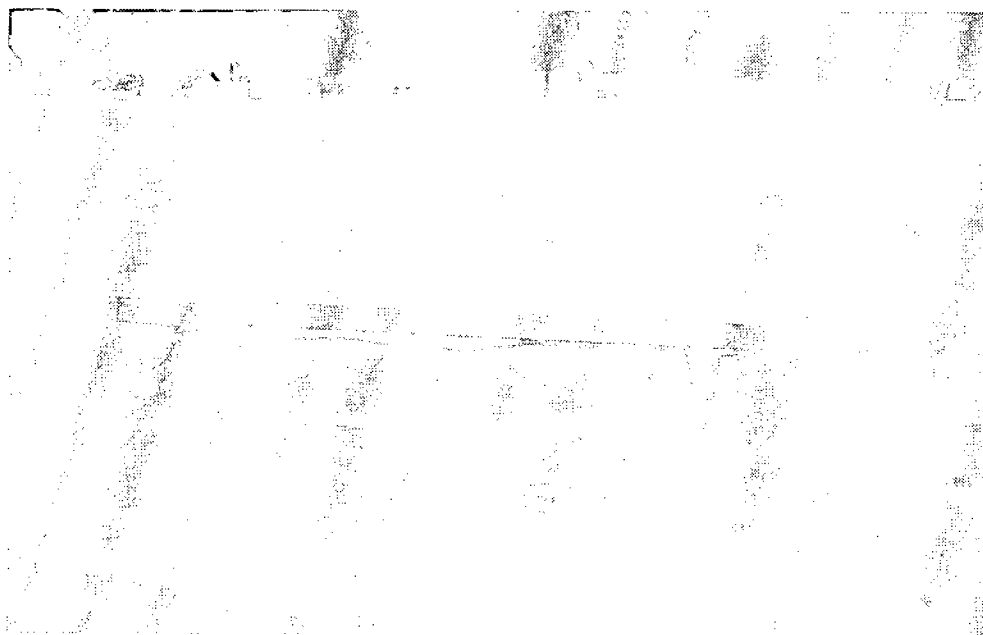
OLDEST KNOWN GRAVE

Col. Daniel Thomason, b. 1801, Tenn., d. 7-28-1839, bur. Old Union Cemetery. In 1821 Col. Daniel Thomason married Mary Jane Denton. They were living in Warren County, Tenn., when the pioneer spirit urged them to move on. Accompanied by his father and other family members, Daniel organized an oxen drawn wagon train. Loading their furniture and supplies, the families started west. They had heard rumors of lush open country there. Their route brought them over rough and hilly terrain, through most of Tennessee and all of the way across Arkansas into Washington County. They stopped first at Rheas Mill. Later hearing about the valley further west, Daniel brought his family into the wild and sparsely settled valley, now known as Cincinnati, Ark. Here the family acquired extensive acreage. Tilling the soil and building a home the family settled in. Daniel's adventure was destined to be short lived. He died July 28, 1839, a young man of 38 years. Some say it was a fever that took his life.

Mary Jane Denton Thomason, continuing with her strong pioneer spirit, lived on the land and reared her children. This same spirit called generations of Thomason's to till this same soil for 150 years.

Computation makes us think Daniel Thomason was buried elsewhere and later moved to Old Union Cemetery.

Cemetery Pioneers



POSTON

WILLIAM POSTON, b. 1779, d. 5-12-1848, bur. Old Union Cemetery, Cincinnati, Ark. Age 69 years. Wm. Poston's grave is covered by a solid 4'x6' rock which stands about 12" above the ground. It is a remarkable monument. W. C. (William Carroll) Poston, b. 1817, d. 10-22-1858, bur. Old Union Cemetery, Cincinnati, Ark. Age 41 years. The Poston's were one of the very earliest pioneers to come into this area. Their acquired lands were extensive. It is reputed that they had cotton plantations and owned slaves to work the crops.

W. C. (WILLIAM CARROLL) POSTON was probably the son of William Poston. Their land laid from near Cincinnati, on west to Indian Territory and then running north. When W. C. (William Carroll) died in 1858, there was a dispute over the land. His wife's name was Bathseba (Tilley). His children were William T. Poston, John J. Poston (under 21) and a daughter Jane Poston McAdams, married to Thomas McAdams. In this dispute, the negro slaves were divided among his heirs.

OLD UNION CEMETERY, CINCINNATI, ARKANSAS

JULY 1846 - JULY 1988

Old Union Cemetery is located one mile south of the village, Cincinnati, Arkansas. This cemetery is very unique. There are graves known to be in this cemetery with no markings at all, others have only a sandstone marker with no names or dates. Many of these are in the southeast corner and mark the graves of slaves, belonging to the various slaver owners in the area. We have found 150 unidentified sandstone markers and 685 identified burials.

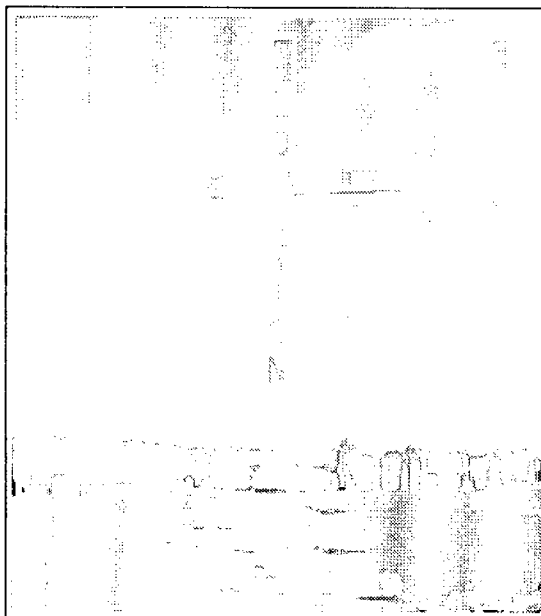

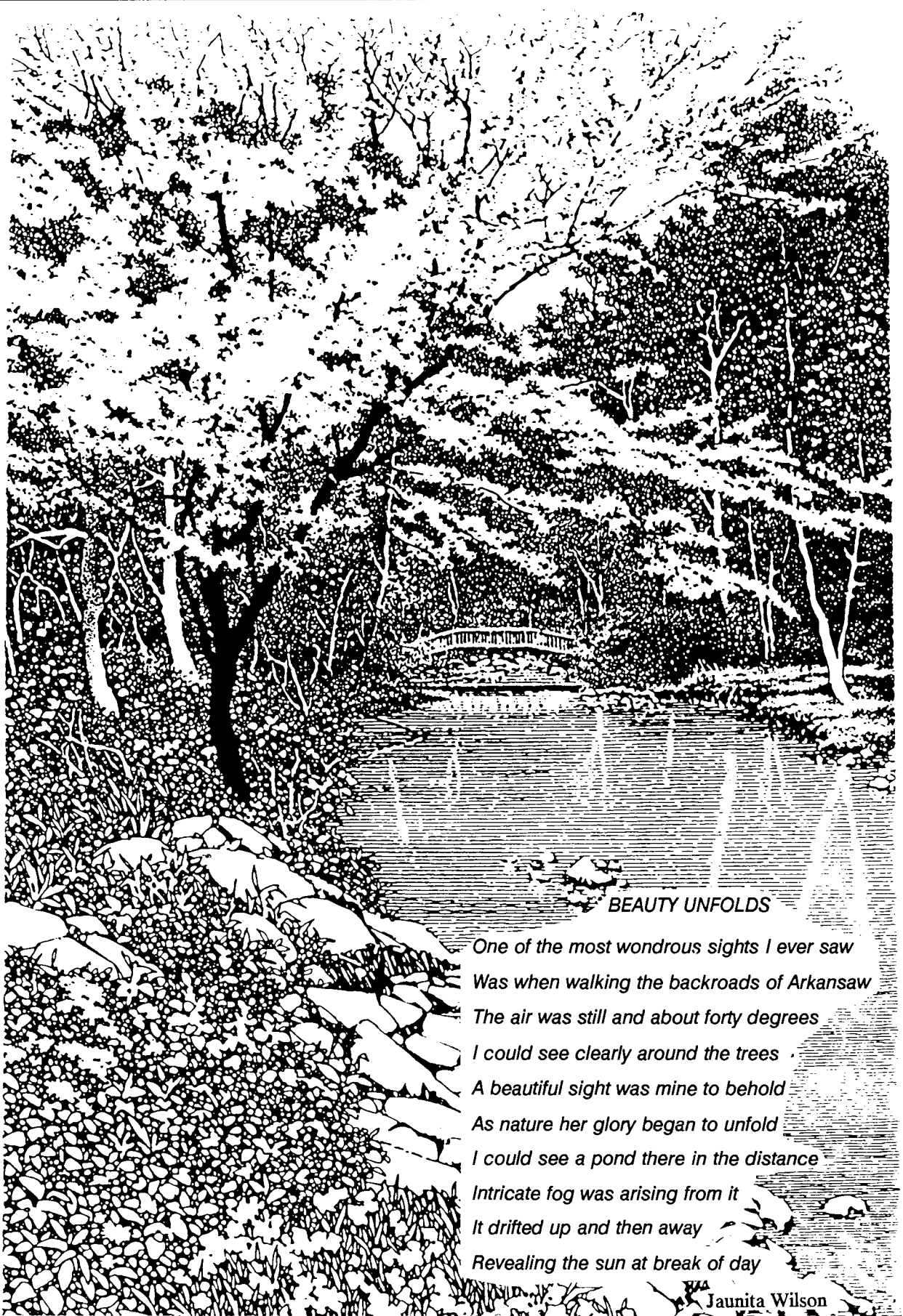
