

3 Injured When Truck Overturns

FAYETTEVILLE, Ark. (Special) — Three youths were injured, one seriously, in a truck accident one-half mile east of Farmington about 1:45 a.m. Sunday.

A sailor Harvey Reed was admitted to the Veterans' hospital at Fayetteville. Reed was diagnosed as having "some brain damage" and a fractured jaw, by the hospital staff. A military plane from Fort Chaffee flew Reed to the Fort Chaffee hospital early Monday morning. At Chaffee his condition was reported as serious, pending other observation.

The other victims are:

Johnny Owens, who is in good condition at a city hospital.

Ronnie Bunnell, who was taken to the hospital, given minor treatments, and released.

The accident occurred on Highway 62 near Farmington about 1:45 a.m. Sunday.

Washington county Deputy Sheriff Earvel Schader said the driver of the pickup truck lost control of the vehicle. The truck traveled 290 feet after it went out of control, hit a culvert, and then turned over three times. The officer estimated that the truck traveled 120 feet while it was overturning.

The home towns of the youths was listed at Farmington.
