





I've been in Lincoln about three years now and when I first moved here I wondered what the young people did for recreation around town. I noticed Rich's Recreation on the corner of the square and decided to visit the place one evening. I remember I felt a little uneasy being new in town walking into a place filled with younger people 1 didn't know and who didn't know me. I found a stick, got a table and shot a few racks by myself. It had been sometime since I had held a stick at the table and I was trying to remember how to shoot, trying not to look too uncomfortable about being a new face in the place.

Then I met Loyd; he asked if I wanted to play a couple games. As we played on into the late night we talked over the table. I learned a number of things that first evening at Rich's Recreation. I learned that Loyd cared about people and especially the young people of the community. As I watched him interact with the young people that night, I learned that they liked him and respected him. He had a way of relating to them. I liked Loyd. Even though we were different in so many ways, there was a lot we shared together. We shared the enjoyment of a good game of eight-hall and a concern for young people.

Since that first night at Rich's Recre u Center my respect for loyd inned to grow. Now it's a

couple years, a lot of evenings, a good many late-night westerns, and a whole lot of eight balls in the pocket later.

With Loyd's passing, some have lost a dear loved one, some a close friend, some a good pool partner, but I really believe that the young people of our community have suffered one of the greatest losses. Somewhere to go when there's nothing else to do in town, someone who cared for them just the way they were, someone to talk to when they were feeling down. All who knew Loyd suffered loss. But please let us never lose the care and concern for the young people of our community that he always carried in his heart. Let's carry it on-in memory of Lovd Rich.

I stand and watch her until at length, she hangs like a speak of white cloud just where the sea and sky come to mingle with each other.

Then romeone at my ride rays: "There, she is gone!"

"Gone where?"

Gone from my right. That is all. She is just as large in mast and hull and spar as she was when she left my side and she is just as able to bear her load of living freight to her destined part.

Her diminished size is in me, not in her. And just at the moment when someone at my side says: "There, she is gone!" there are other eyes watching here coming, and other voices ready to take up the glad shout: "Here she comes!"

And that is dying.
