## Coat of Arms

## Historiography



Kirk

The Kirk Coat of Arms illustrated left was drawn by an heraldic artist from information officially recorded in ancient heraldic archives. Documentation for the Kirk Coat of Arms design can be found in Riestap Amorial General. Heraldic artists of old developed their own unique language to describe an individual Coat of Arms. In their language, the Arms (shield) is as follows:

"Gu. a crozier or, and sword ar. saltireways,  
on a chief of the second a thistle vert."

Above the shield and helmet is the Crest which is described as:

"A crozier and dagger in saltire."

When translated the blazon also describes the original colors of the Kirk Arms and Crest as it appeared centuries ago.

Family mottoes are believed to have originated as battle cries in medieval times.

A Motto was recorded with this Kirk Coat of Arms:

"OPTIMUM QUOD PRIMUM"

Individual surnames originated for the purpose of more specific identification. The four primary sources for second names were: occupation, location, father's name, or personal characteristics. The surname Kirk appears to be locational in origin, and is believed to be associated with the meaning, "dweller near a church or religious house." The supplementary sheet included with this report is designed to give you more information to further your understanding of the origin of names. Different spellings of the same original surname are a common occurrence. Dictionaries of surnames indicate probable spelling variations of Kirk to be Kyrk. Although bearers of the old and distinguished Kirk name comprise a small fraction of the population there are a number who have established for it a significant place in history. They include: SIR PATRICK KIRK (Kyrk) Chaplain of the Alter of St. Mary, Perth (1456). ANDREW KIRK, Was a Charter Witness at Invarary (1608). JOHN KIRK, A Bailis of St. Andrews (1520). He was as member, of Incorporated Society of Artists. Exhibited medals of the Royal Family and others (1773-1776). EDWARD NORRIS KIRK (1802-1874) American clergyman. Agent, Board of Foreign Missions, Princeton Theological Seminary. He aided the establishment of the first American Protestant Service in Paris. He was the author of "Lectures on Christ's Parables", in 1856. JOHN FOSTER KIRK (1824-1904) Historian. He was born in Canada, and came to America about 1842. He was the Editor of the "Lippincott's Magazine", from 1870 to 1886. SIR JOHN KIRK (1832-1922) Scottish administrator in Africa and physician and naturalist on David Livingstone's second expedition to Zambezi from 1858 to 1863. As Counsel General in 1873, of Zanzibar, he persuaded the Sultan to abolish the slave trade. He was knighted in 1881. 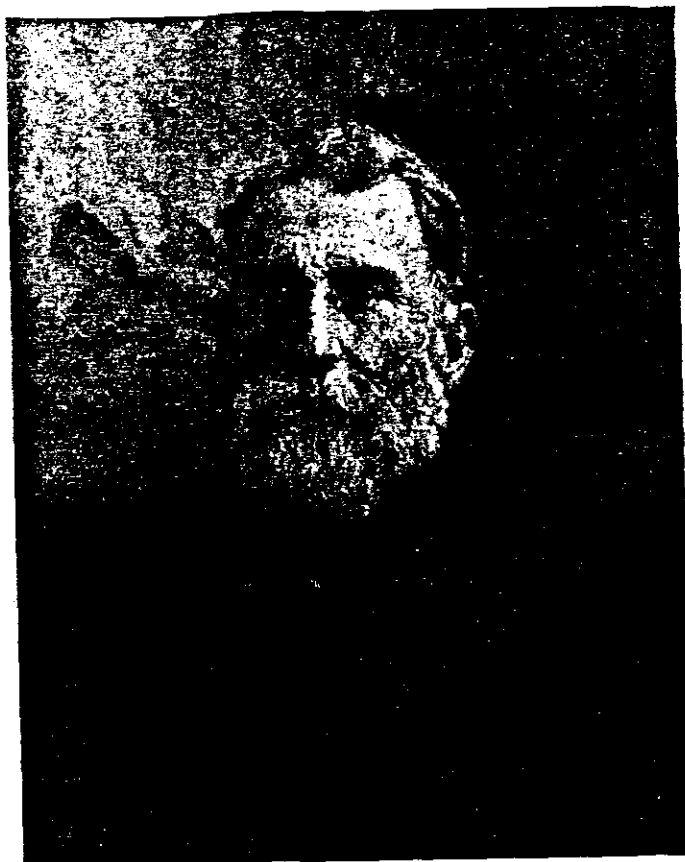

Kirk, enlisted in the Confederate Army and served as Q.M, Sgt, From Sept, 12 to October 31, 1861 with the 24th, Regiment Tennessee Infantry, He was discharged on Nov, 16, 1861 at the age of 37 and according to records with paid as a private to the time of discharge, John Kirk and Nancy Plumlee, Kirk, moved to Summers, Arkansas, in Dec, 2, 1875 where he purchased land from Calvin Williams,

The four Kirks are Brothers Stephen S. Kirk, and Dennis Carrol Kirk, and George Kirk, and John H. Kirk, Stephen and John Kirk, were in the Civil War and George also, Stephen and George were twins, and John H. Kirk, is Great Grand father to Clara Risley,

Dennis Carrol Kirk, came from Tennessee, to Arkansas, and homesteaded land in Summers, Arkansas, about Sept, 6, 1886. He came from Jackson Conuty, Tennessee, and John also came to Arkansas, from Tennessee John Kirk came first and Dennis Carrol Kirk, about 11 years after

Mr, Samuel Plumlee;

Kind Sir, I received your letter 10th. Glad to hear from you but sorry to hear you were wounded. (Samuel wounded in action in World War 1. R.D.P.) in regard to you I thought you were Dr. Plumlee's son. His name was Dr. Monroe Plumlee, he had a boy by the name of Samuel.

My father's name is Samuel Plumlee, but they all call him Ret. My Grandfather's name was George Plumlee. they were Tennessee by birth but I was borned and raised in Texas. I have an uncle and several cousins in Arkansas. His given name was Bill Plumlee. He had some boys by the name of Deb, Carrol. Dee and Monroe. By now they are all old men.

Well close hoping to hear from you and tell me all you can of your people.

## Denton Plumlee

Dr, Monroe Plumlee did not have a son, Samuel, nor did William have a son, unless it was a nickname. William Plumlee would have been the great uncle of George H, Plumlee, but there are enough names mentioned to convince me that William Plumlee was the son of Denton and Nancy (Johnson) Plumlee (R.D.P.)# is interesting to learn that the Plumlees were trying to establish their kin some fifty years ago (R.D.P.).

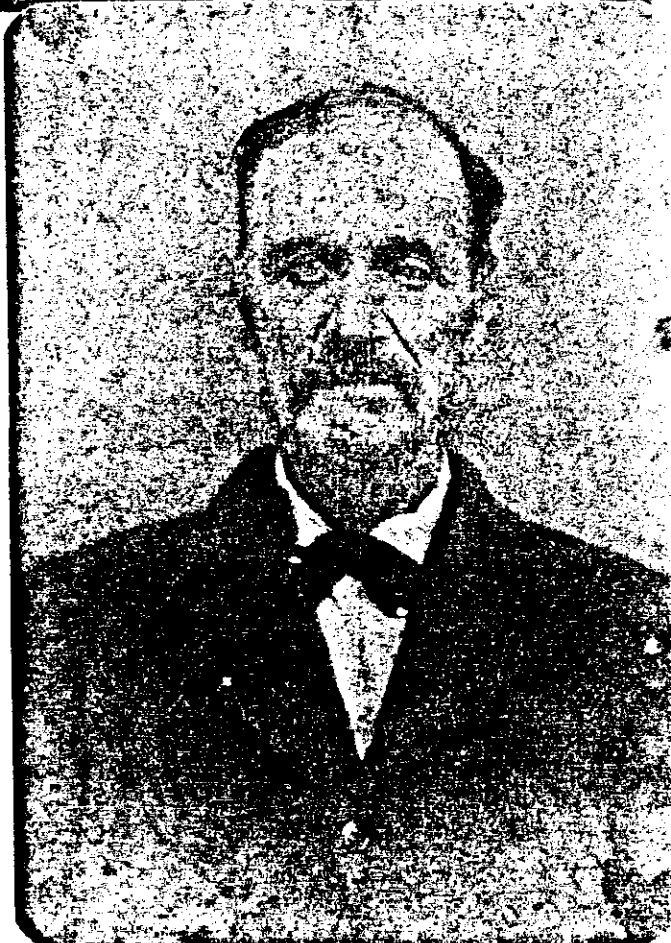


Dear Mrs. Hilton;
