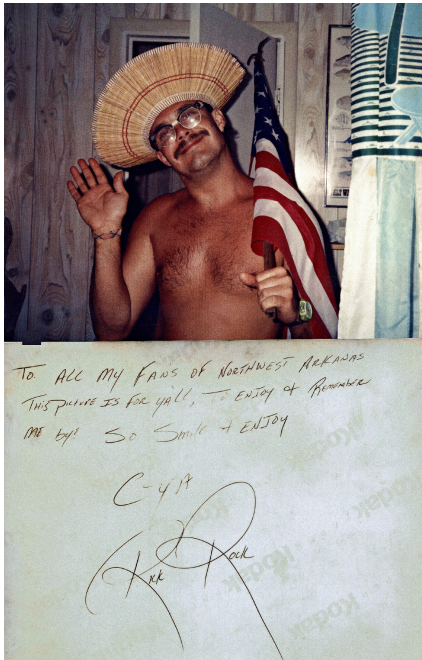

Ricky Wayne Anderson
