

Mrs. Avery Brought Here for Burial

Mrs. Azlea Avery died at her home in Gypsum, Kan., Feb. 10 of pneumonia following influenza, after an illness of one week. The remains reached here Wednesday and was taken to the Sharp Graveyard for burial. They were accompanied by her daughter, Mrs. Stella Noonan of Gypsum, and Mr. Bert Oliver of this place, he having reached her bedside Saturday before her death.
