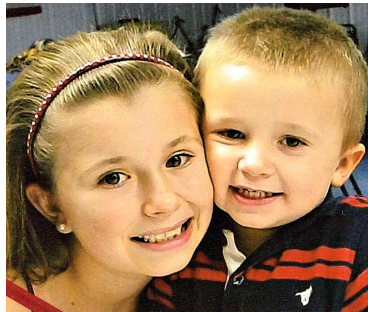
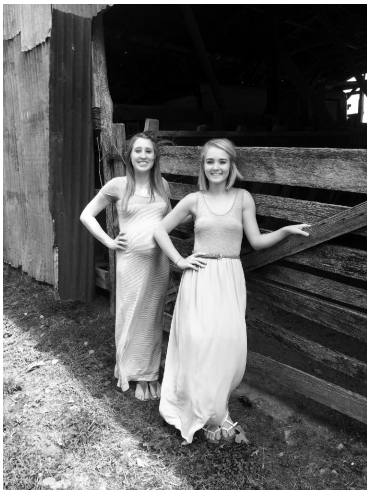


Mary L. Barnes
