

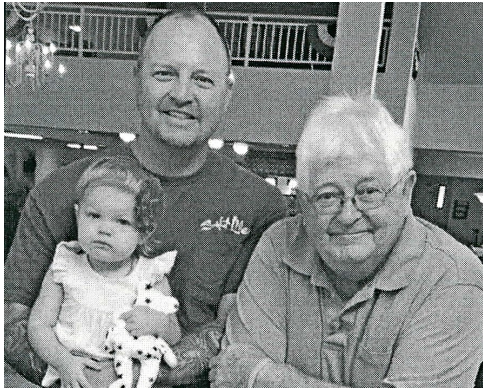
Bobby Bateman
