

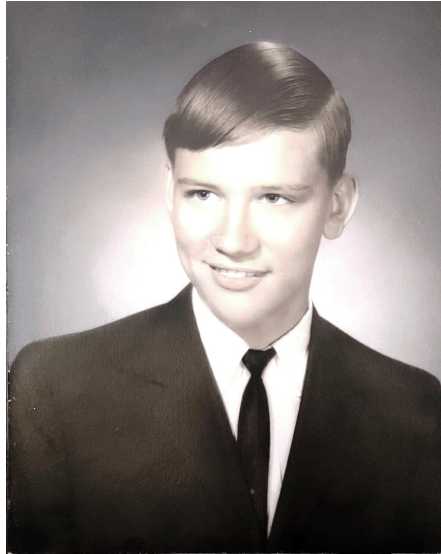
Jack Everett Batson Jr.
