

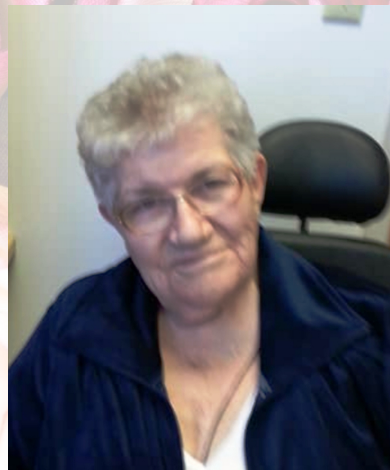
**Ila Jean Beaty**
