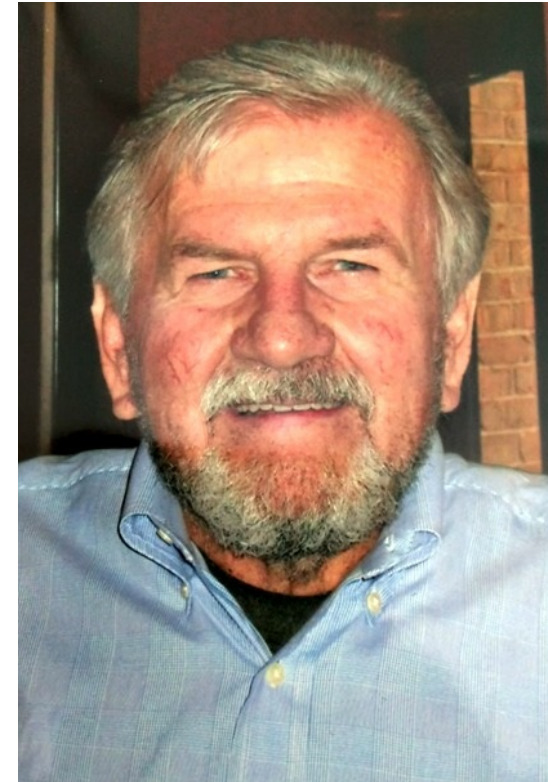
**Sidney Stephen Bethard**
