She was preceded in death by her husband, Troy Bond; one toddler son, Jimmy Dee Hale and a grand-daughter, Amy Hale.

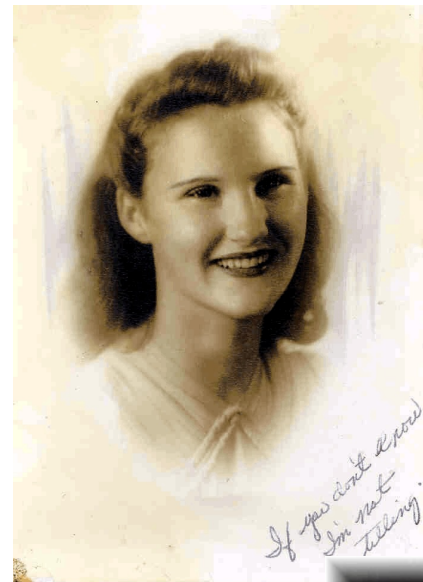
