

Randy Burris

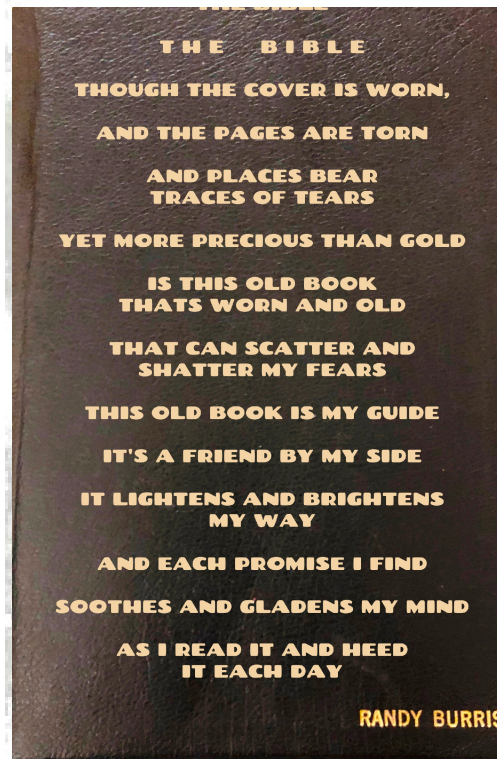
