

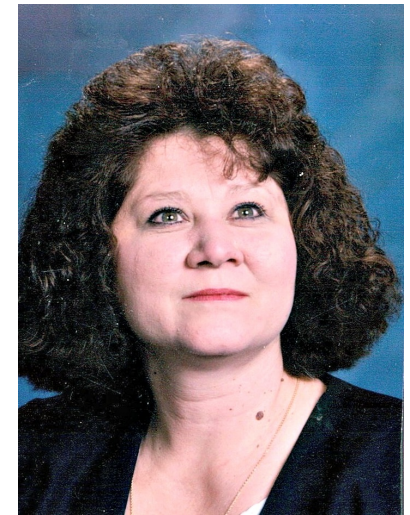
### **Rhonda Sue Calvert**
