

Calvin Douglas Chambers, 71, a resident of Prairie Grove, passed away Thursday, July 1, 2021 in Fayetteville. In February he was chosen to represent Arkansas during a week long tribute for National Purple Heart Honor Mission in New York. That was to take place in April of this year but backed the event to September due to covid. When the children were younger Doug participated in their activities such as Boy Scouts, Base Ball and any other activities. He loved to travel, hike, fish and camp. Above all he made us know how important his family was to him.

He was preceded in death by his parents; two brothers, Virgil Jerald Chambers and Wesley Eugene Chambers; one sister, Shirley Corene Chambers.

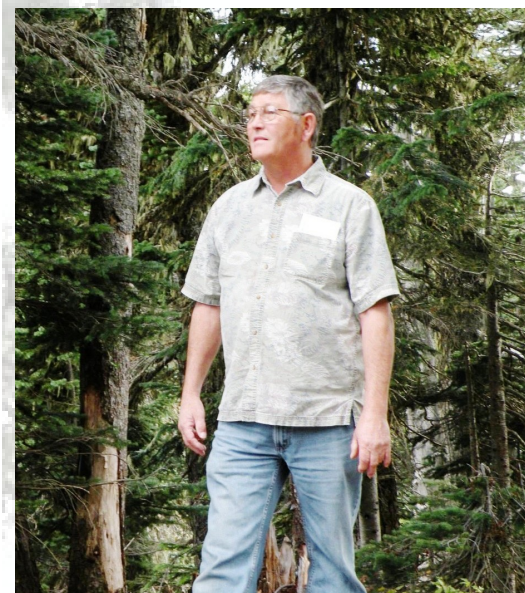
