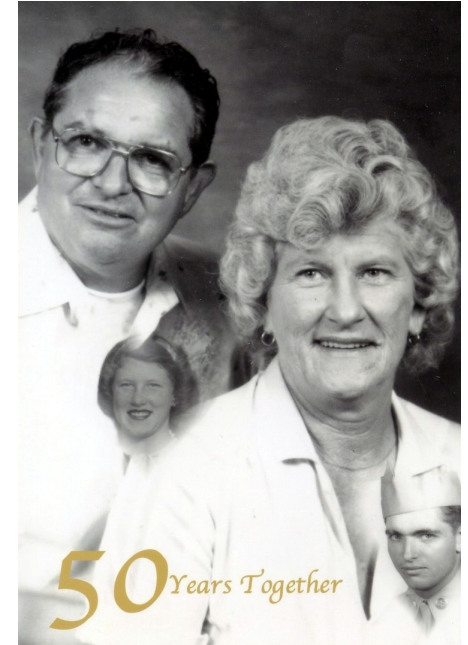

Davis (Davie) Jefferson Cheatham
