

### John Frank "J.F." Cheatham



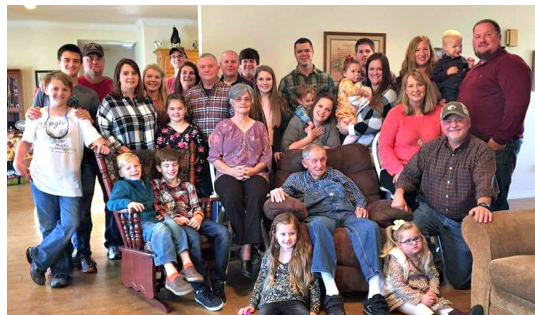
